



MARQUETTE COUNTY TOWNSHIPS & CITIES

AN INTRODUCTION TO MARQUETTE COUNTY

Marquette County was first visited by French explorers, missionaries, and fur traders or voyageurs. They usually camped at Little Presque Isle. Iron ore was discovered in 1844. As with other mining areas there was an immediate demand

for laborers. The first immigrants were the Cornish, French Canadians, Germans and Irish who worked in the mines or at the developing ore docks in Marquette. As the mines expanded and mineral production increased so did the number of variety of immigrants. Probably the most predominant ethnic group was the Finns. Other immigrants were attracted by the jobs in the timber industry, commercial fishing, and farming south of Marquette.

The ethnic development in the county was complete. There was the development of ethnic churches, newspapers, mutual beneficial societies and other related organizations. Today many of these ethnic groups maintain their cultural heritage like the Scandinavian Mid-Summer Festival held in Marquette and the dinners and entertainment of the Paisano Club.
