## AN INTRODUCTION TO CHIPPEWA COUNTY

Sault Ste Marie, on the St. Mary's River was first visited by a French voyageur, Etienne Brulé in the 1620s. It remained the gateway to the Lake Superior through the colonial period attracting French and English settlers. In 1820s Fort Brady was established and many of the officers and soldiers were foreign-born. The community attracted many immigrants especially those from Canada. Peter Barbeau, a French Canadian merchant came to dominate the community and its environs.

In the late nineteenth and early twentieth century, immigrants were attracted to the Soo because of the need for workers to expand the St. Mary's River Canal, and to work in the tannery, union carbide plant, and woolen mill. These plants were discontinued by the 1960s. Many English Canadians were

attracted to the rich farmland to the south of the city as were Polish immigrants to the area around Goetzville and Italians north of Hessel. Chippewa County was an atypical county where immigrants were attracted there by the industry which flourished as opposed to a mining or timber base. NB: Chippewa Township was organized from Soo and Superior Townships since 1910 and Hulbert Township was organized from part of Soo Township in 1921.
