EXTRACTS FROM LIGHT-HOUSE BOARD REGULATIONS.

No property of any description whatsoever, belonging to the Light-House Establishment, in charge of any person employed in the light-house service, shall be delivered to any other person or disposed of in any way without authority of the Board. Whenever transfers are authorized, receipts shall be taken in triplicate—one to be transmitted at the time, and a second forwarded, with the regular return of property expenditures, to the Board.

No article of public property shall be disposed of by gift, loan, or in any other way, for the personal use or benefit of any one.

All persons having charge of property belonging to the Light-House Establishment are held responsible for its preservation and safe keeping, and are required to take all proper measures to protect it from loss, damage, or waste; and when such property is not satisfactorily accounted for, the officer or other person to whom it was intrusted shall be charged with its value.
