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NEW DEPOT ASSURED, SOUTH SHORE ROAD WILL ERECT IT ON FRONT STREET
PLANS WILL BE HERE SHORTLY, CONSIDERABLE GRADING ON THE SITE COMPLETED
THIS WEEK, IT IS PRESUMED THAT STRUCTURE WILL BE COMMENSURATE WITH
COMPANY'S IMPORTANCE AND CREDIATABLE TO THE CITY.

As is generally understood at this time, Marquette is going to have a new South Shore Depot this year. The plans and specifications have yet to be received, so it is now impossible to go into a detailed description of the proposed new structure, which is to be located on Front Street; between Main and Spring Streets, on the company's land which has served the purpose of a yard for many years passed. The grading which has been going on at this IX point the passed week or ten days is now complete and the grade has been made level between Front and Third Streets, wherehereXtofore there has been a considerable down grade to Front Street.

The new depot will certainly go up this year, the preliminaries for its construction being arranged as soon as the plans and specifications are at hand. Not having these available yesterday, General Manager W.F. Fitch did not care to say much concerning the proposed structure, although he stated positively that its erection would procede this season.

The importement will necessitate the moving of EPickands & company's coal office, which now occupies a section of the railroad company's land at the site of the proposed depot. Mr. Fitch was unable to state positively yesterday what disposition would be made of it, but it is presumed that it will be placed on some of the company's centrally located downtown realty.

Questioned as to the authenticity of the report that the cut to the north of the depot site is to be filled, Mr. Fitch said that there was nothing in the story and that cut will remain in its present condition.
