Accident Report

An accident occured on the Duluth South Shore and Atlantic Railway at Marquette on the 18th day of June 1887, at 4 o'clock pm, caused by:

Stephen Jobe, brakeman with switch engine no. 59, falling off back end of engine tank (in a fit). Wheel passed over his right foot, requiring the amputation of small toe and one next to it. Also some injury to head, but doctor reports him as progressing nicely, and does not anticipate any further trouble.

Have learned since this occured that he was subject to such spells. Will not be able to employ him at such class of work again.

Casualties - One employe injured.
