

Accident Report - December 17, 1887.

An accident occurred upon the Duluth South Shore and Atlantic Railway near Ishpeming on the 17th day of December 1887 at 9:30 o'clock A. M. caused by

Richard Nugent, brakeman with switch engine in Ishpeming yard losing a portion of middle finger on right hand. He was pulling pin between engine and ore car no. 992, when engine slacked back; his finger caught between pin and dead wood taking off a portion. He was off work 3 weeks, but is again on duty.
