WEST-BOUND.

No. 1, HOUGHTON EXPRESS—Leaving Detroit 6:00 P. M., daily, has Wagner Palace Sleeping Car attached Detroit to Marquette without change, arriving Marquette 2:00 P. M. Passengers for Duluth and West connect with No. 3 at Marquette.

No. 3, DULUTH LIMITED—Leaving Sault Ste. Marie 11:30 A. M., daily, has Wagner Vestibuled Buffet Sleeping Car attached, running through to Duluth without change, arriving Duluth 7:05 A. M., making direct connections in Union Depot for St. Paul, Minneapolis and all points West, Southwest and Northwest.
