In the biography of William B. Hatfield, pioneer merchant of Ewen, Mi., it mentions that as a member of the firm of Clark Farnham & Co., Remus, Mi., he came to Even to engage in business in 1889. An engine house and water tank were the only buildings to be seen on the village site. He at once erected a building, put in a stock of general merchandise and subsequently put up a saw and shigle mill.
