Established under the philosophy that a University has a threefold task of teaching, research, and practical service to individuals and communities, the Job Corps Center has processed over 1,125 girls since its opening June 28, 1966.

Women attending the Job Corps Center take courses which are geared to their individual needs and abilities. Included in each enrollee's curriculum are basic education courses to improve their skills in arithmetic, reading, and oral and written communication and specialized occupational courses of their choosing.

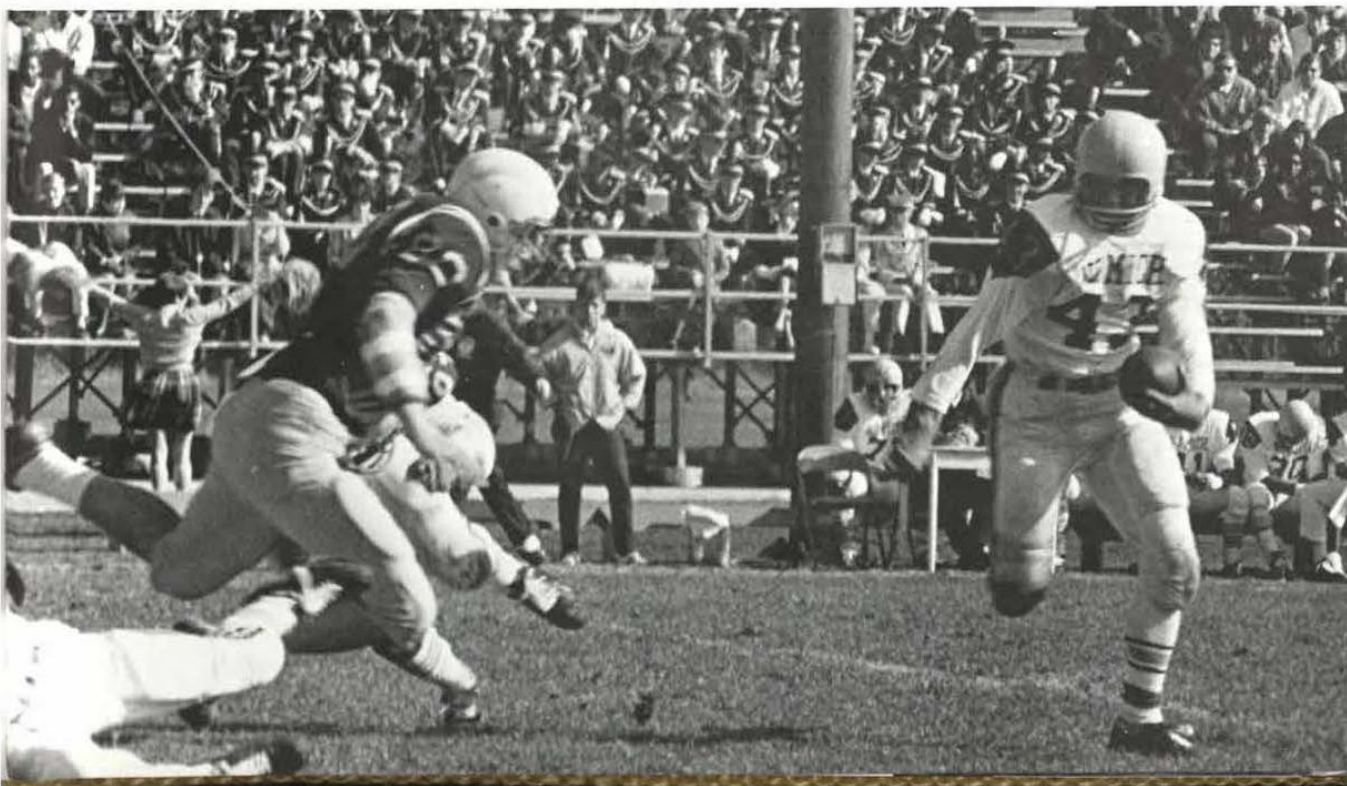
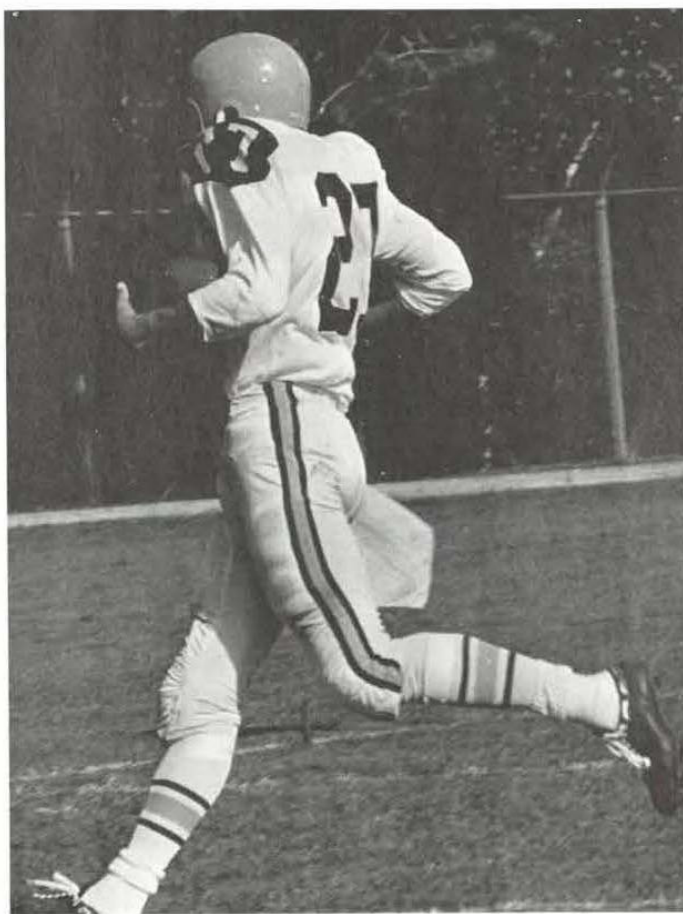


Frosh Finish First Season 2-1

Victories were won against Central Michigan 42-21, and Hillsdale 23-22.

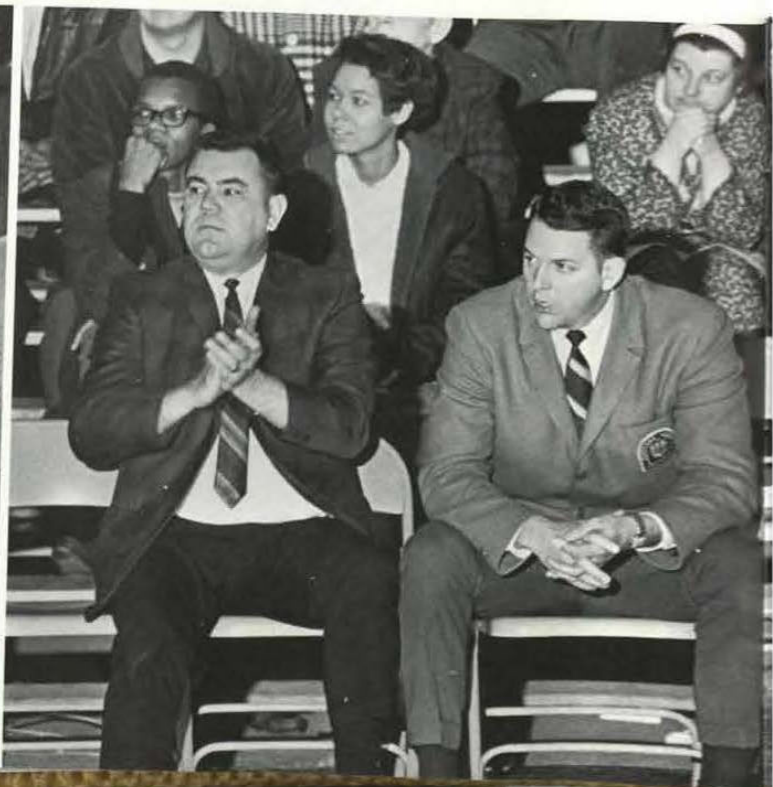
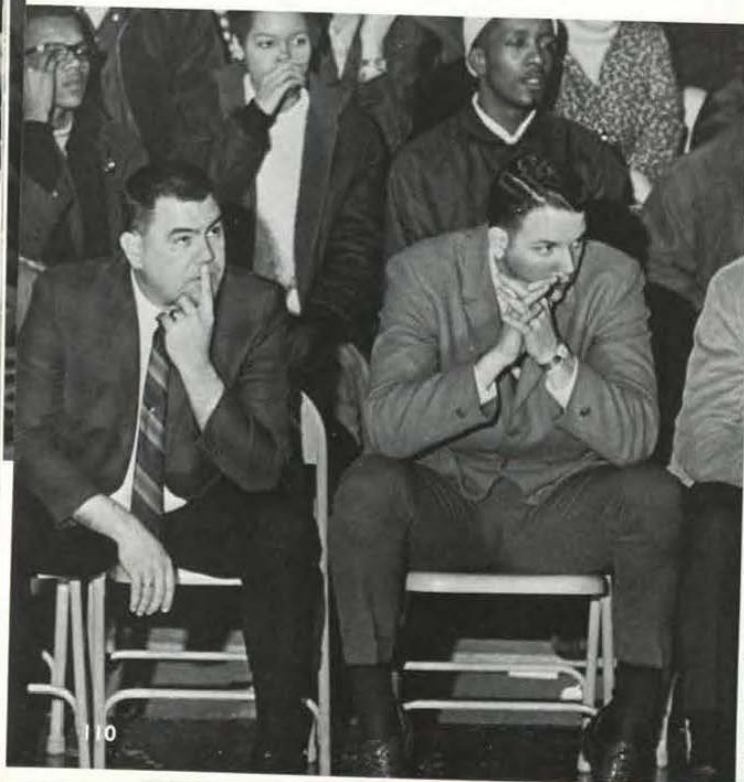
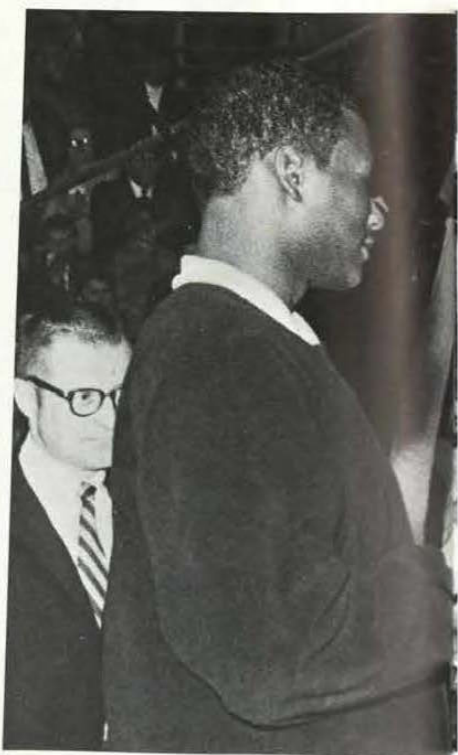
Northern's only freshman loss was at the hands of Wool Bowl Champion Grand Rapids Junior College.

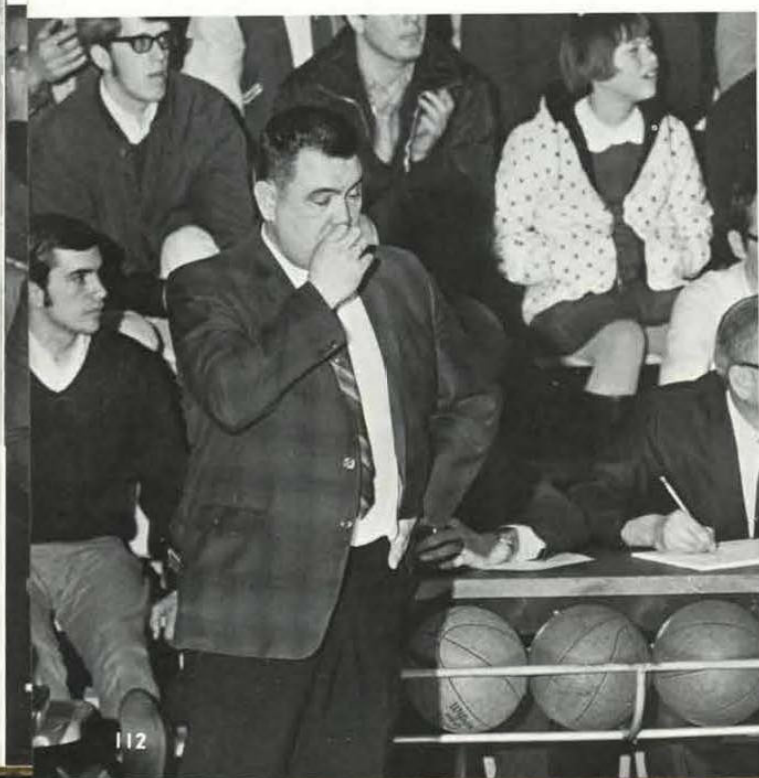

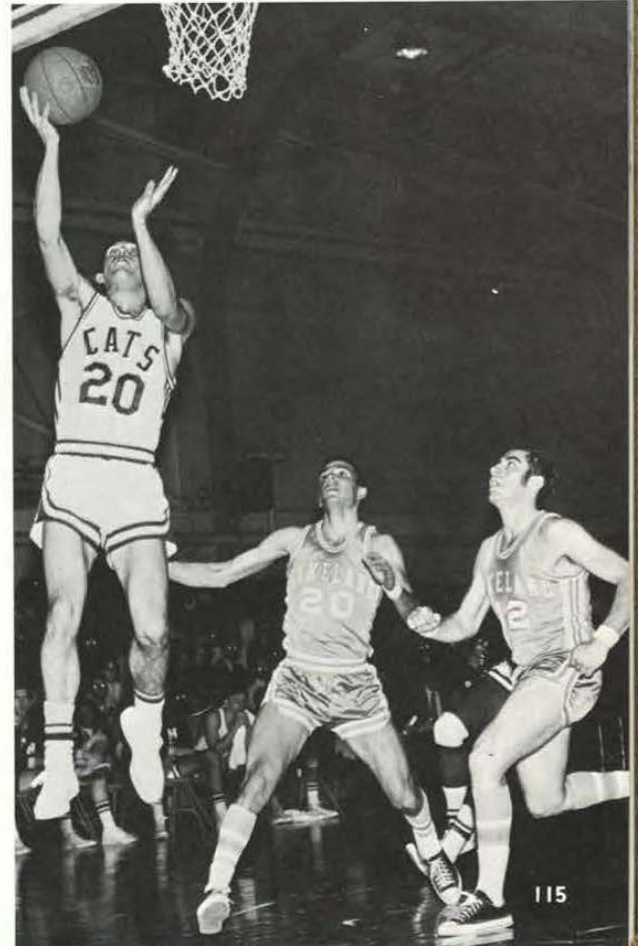
Rose Captures Lead in Career Points
