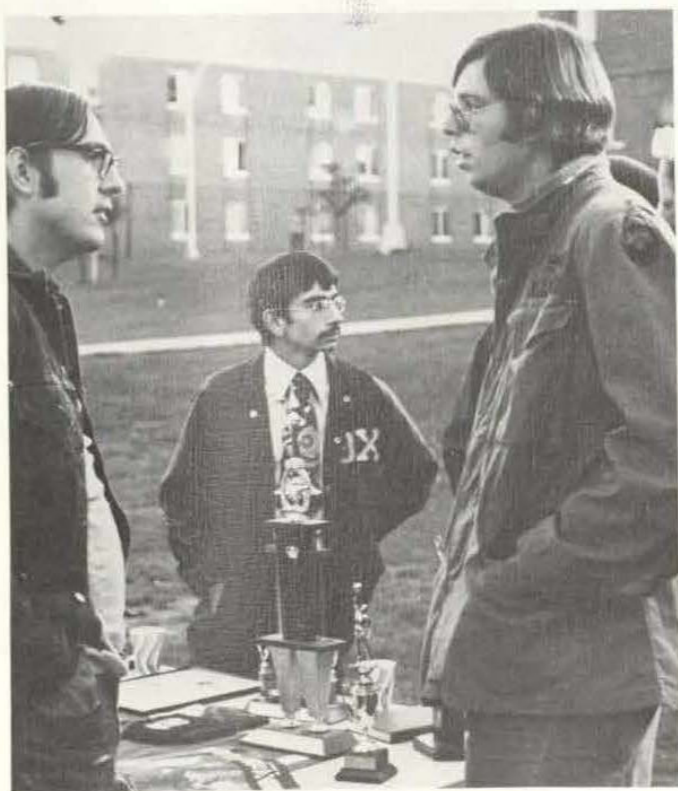




## *Organizations Night*

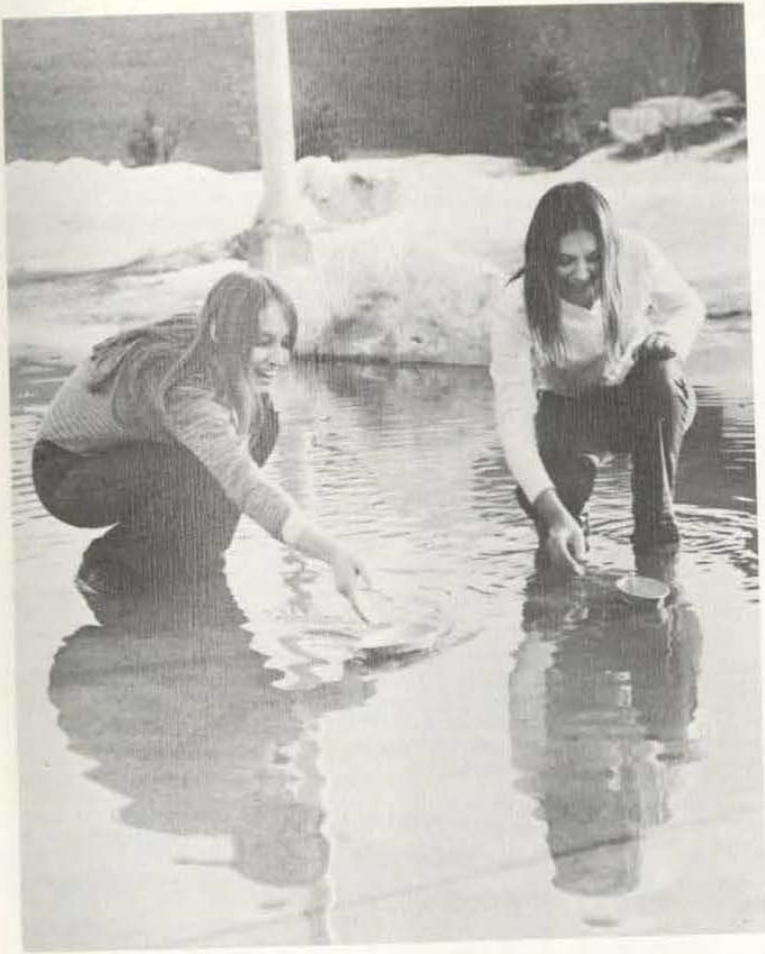

## Academic Staff

### VICE PRESIDENT



Dr. Jack Rombouts, Vice-President, Executive Assistant, and Secretary to the Board of Control, completed his Doctor's degree at Michigan State University in 1959. He has been active in the affairs of Northern Michigan University since his arrival here.

Prior to his service at Northern, Dr. Rombouts served as Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction and has been on several committees pertaining to education in the state of Michigan. Several publications have been written by him concerning matters of education in our state.

Dr. Rombouts has served as chairman of the Human Rights Commission and Vice President of Marquette Community Chest. He was selected as recipient of the "Native Son" award during Michigan Week of 1966.

### ASSISTANT VICE PRESIDENT



A graduate of Northern Michigan University, Paul Suomi received his B.A. in 1962 and his Master's in Education just recently. Upon receipt of his B.A., Mr. Suomi was employed as Northern's Sports Information Director and then as University News Director. In 1969 he was appointed to his present position, Assistant to the Vice President and Executive Assistant to the President.

Mr. Suomi is active in many campus organizations, including the University Advisory Council, Student Wage and Policy Committee, and the Housing Appeals Board. He is also chairman of the Parents' Weekend Program Committee.

Mr. Suomi's other affiliations include the Human Rights Commission, of which he is secretary, The U.P. Sports Hall of Fame Council, and the Executive Committee of the N.M.U. Alumni Association. In 1962 he received recognition in Outstanding Young Men of America.

## BUSINESS AND FINANCE



Vice-President for Business and Finance, Leo Van Tassel has been a member of the N.M.U. faculty since 1946. He received his B.A. in education at Western Michigan University and M.A. at the University of Michigan, also in education.

His present position includes supervision and custody of all deeds, contracts, agreements and trust indentures of the University, and the collection, custody and accounting for all University resources.

Membership in The Administration Council, University Advisory Council, Association of School Business Officers of the U.S. and Canada, and the National Association of Colleges and Business Officers, are some of his affiliations.

### ACADEMIC AFFAIRS



A native of Marquette, R. Thomas Peters is Assistant to the President for Administrative Affairs and Director of Alumni Relations. He is also Executive Director of the Northern Michigan University Development Fund.

Mr. Peters received his M.A. in School Administration and Supervision and was among the first class to receive a master's degree from N.M.U. He became Director of Alumni Relations in 1957 and has held this position steadily since 1963. Recently he was appointed to the new Administrative Affairs position.

Mr. Peters is affiliated with several Marquette organizations. As a former football and golf letterman, he is also a member of the Golden Wildcat Club, Alumni "N" Club, and the Athletic Council.

Since 1968, Dr. Jacob Vinocur has held the position of Vice President for Academic Affairs at N.M.U. After receiving his Ph. D. in English at the University of Wisconsin, Dr. Vinocur held the Chair in American Literature and Civilization, a position endowed by "Readers' Digest" at the University of Dijon in France.

Dr. Vinocur was one of twelve recipients awarded Phillips Fellowships in University Administration for the academic year 1965-66, while working at Duke University. He has taught at several universities and in 1966 was appointed Associate Dean of the Graduate School at Michigan State University. Dr. Vinocur has also written three publications concerning different aspects of education.

#### ASSISTANT FOR ACADEMIC AFFAIRS



Dr. Glenn Stevens, Assistant to the V.P. for Academic Affairs, received his Ph. D. in Administration and Higher Education from M.S.U.

Among his many university affiliations, Dr. Stevens is a member of the Ad Hoc Committee on Student Rights and Responsibilities and chairs the Academic Proficiency Committee. He is involved in promoting student academic services, including the development of a more effective academic advising system.

Dr. Stevens is involved in several Marquette Community activities, including Big Brothers of Marquette and the Board of Directors for the Iron Rangers. Professional affiliations include The American Association of Higher Education and Phi Delta Kappa.

#### CONTINUING EDUCATION AND GRADUATE STUDIES



As Vice-President for Continuing Education and Dean of Graduate Studies, Dean Roland S. Strolle has instituted academic programs for prison inmates and native Americans and has established a two-year law enforcement training program.

Dr. Strolle received his M.A. at the University of Minnesota and his doctorate at Michigan State. Prior to his appointment at N.M.U., he served thirteen years as a university administrator for Western Michigan University and nine years with the State Department of Education. From 1966 to 1967, the Dean was a Fulbright Lecturer in Turkey and Cyprus. He has also been the recipient of a distinguished service award from Phi Delta Kappa and the 1970 Distinguished Alumni Award from N.M.U.

#### STUDENT AFFAIRS



Formerly Dean of Students and Professor and Head of the Music Department at Northern, Dr. Allan L. Niemi is presently Vice President of Student Affairs. He received his Doctor of Education degree in music at Columbia University Teachers College.

Dr. Niemi has been recognized by Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities, Who's Who in the Midwest, Community Leaders of America, and The National Register of Prominent Americans and International Notables.

Some of his affiliations include the National Association of Student Personnel and Guidance, the American Personnel and Guidance Association, and the Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, an honorary music fraternity.

#### DEAN OF STUDENTS



Dr. L. G. Kafer, who received his master's degree in Guidance and Counseling at Michigan State University, has been Dean of Students at N.M.U. since 1969. Some of Dr. Kafer's previous experiences include Admission's Counselor at Adrian College, Assistant Dean of Men at the University of Cincinnati, and Associate Dean of Students at Northern prior to becoming Dean of Students.

Dr. Kafer is married and has two children. Skiing, camping, and other outdoor activities are among his favorite pastimes.

The American Personnel and Guidance Associations, membership in Kiwanis International, and Outstanding Young Men of America in 1967, are included as some of Dr. Kafer's affiliations.



#### DEAN OF THE SCHOOL OF NURSING



N.M.U.'s Dean of the School of Nursing, Mrs. Margaret Rettig, received her Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing Education and Master of Science degree in Education at two leading Indiana Universities.

Educational director and supervisor at Parkview Methodist School of Nursing at Fort Wayne, Indiana, and supervisor and clinical instructor at Parkview Memorial Hospital, also in Fort Wayne, are among her previous occupational experiences.

Mrs. Rettig's professional affiliations include The American Business Women, and The Michigan Society of Gerontology.

#### DEAN OF THE SCHOOL OF EDUCATION



Prior to receiving his post as Dean of Education, Dr. Wilbert A. Berg held several positions at Northern. In the past years he has served as professor and head of the Psychology and Education department and as acting dean of the School of Graduate Studies.

The Dean completed his education at the University of Missouri, where he received his doctorate in Counseling and Guidance in 1952. Postdoctoral occupations included positions at Central Missouri State College and Syracuse University.

His professional affiliations include The American Psychological Association and American Personnel and Guidance Association. Dr. Berg is also a member of Phi Delta Kappa and Psi Chi.

#### DEAN OF THE SCHOOL OF BUSINESS



A graduate from U.C.L.A., Stanford University, and University of Southern California, Dr. Donald H. Hangen is presently NMU's Dean of the School of Business. Some of his previous occupations include experience as a freshman track and cross country coach at U.C.L.A., a Personnel Officer in the Air Force, three years as a management consultant, and five years as a teacher at California State University.

Dean Hangen was an American Marketing Association Doctorial Consortium Fellow and also received European research fellowships.

#### DEAN OF THE SCHOOL OF ARTS AND SCIENCES



Dean Robert B. Glenn, who holds a B.A. in Chemistry and a Ph. D. in English, is presently the Dean of the School of Arts and Sciences. 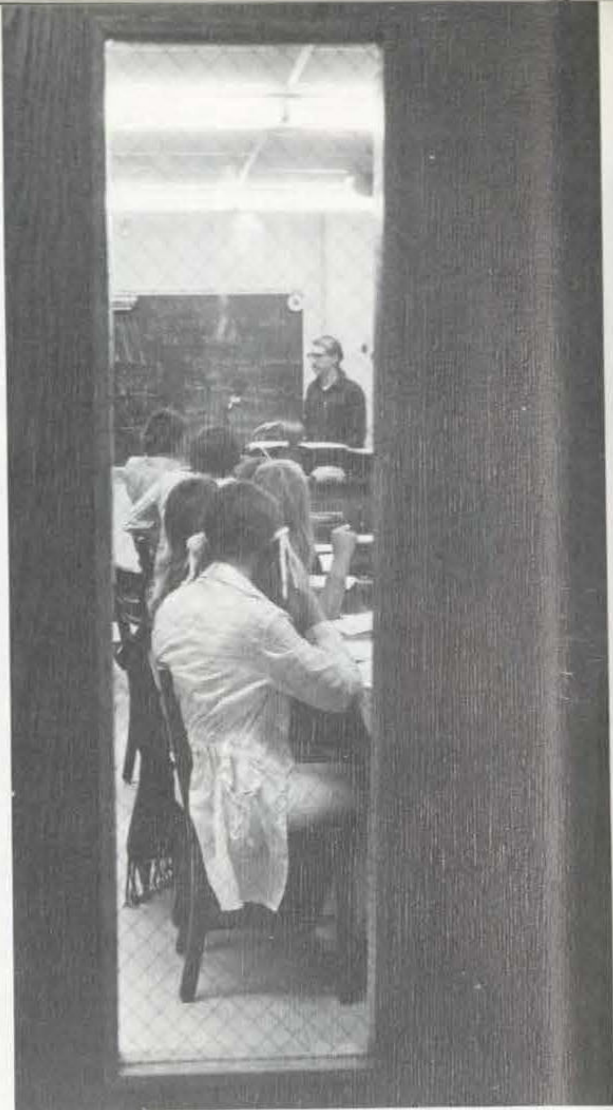

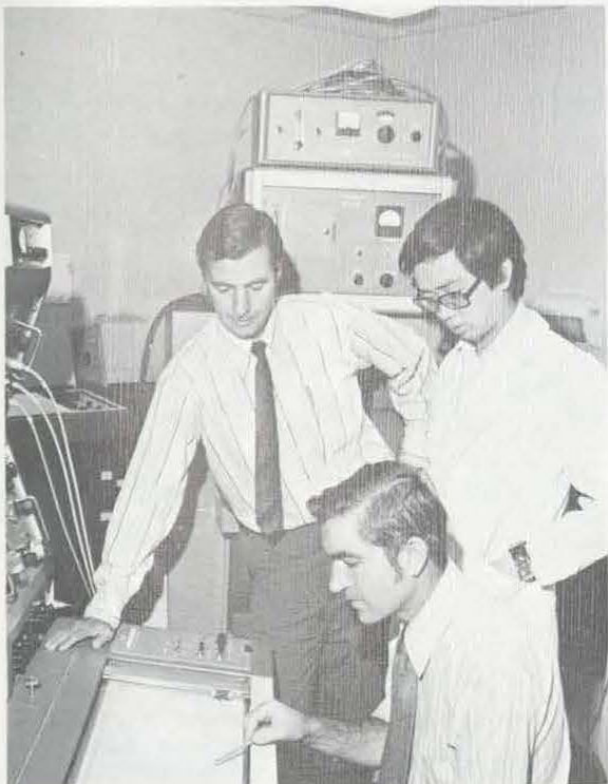
## *The School of Arts and Sciences*

Variety is the key descriptive word for the School of Arts and Sciences. Students may select courses from any of the fifteen departmental areas, each of which offers a diversity of informative and relevant courses. Majors or minors in these areas prepare students for careers in government and industry, public school education, professional programs, entry to graduate school, or provide a liberal education basis. The departments offer a myriad of extra curricular activities like special interest clubs, student art exhibits and music recitals, and opportunities for overseas study.

Graduate degrees are offered in seven of the program areas in The School of Arts and Sciences. The Master of Arts degree is conferred by the Biology, Chemistry, English, Geography, History, Music and Mathematics Departments. In cooperation with the School of Education, graduate programs leading to an M.A. in Education are also offered. Many graduate students are employed at the university as teaching assistants. Others are involved in federally funded research programs such as the shoreline erosion problem currently being investigated under the leadership of Dr. J. Hughes, associate professor in the Geography department.

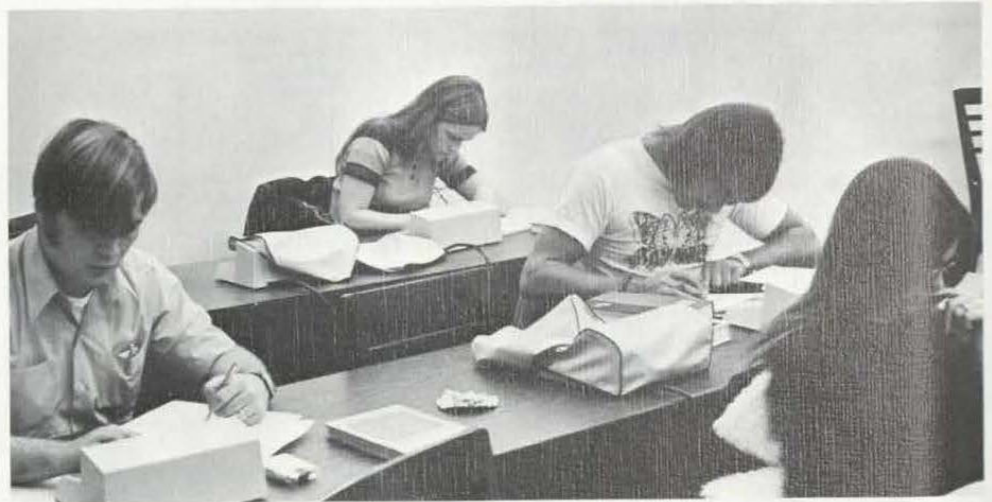

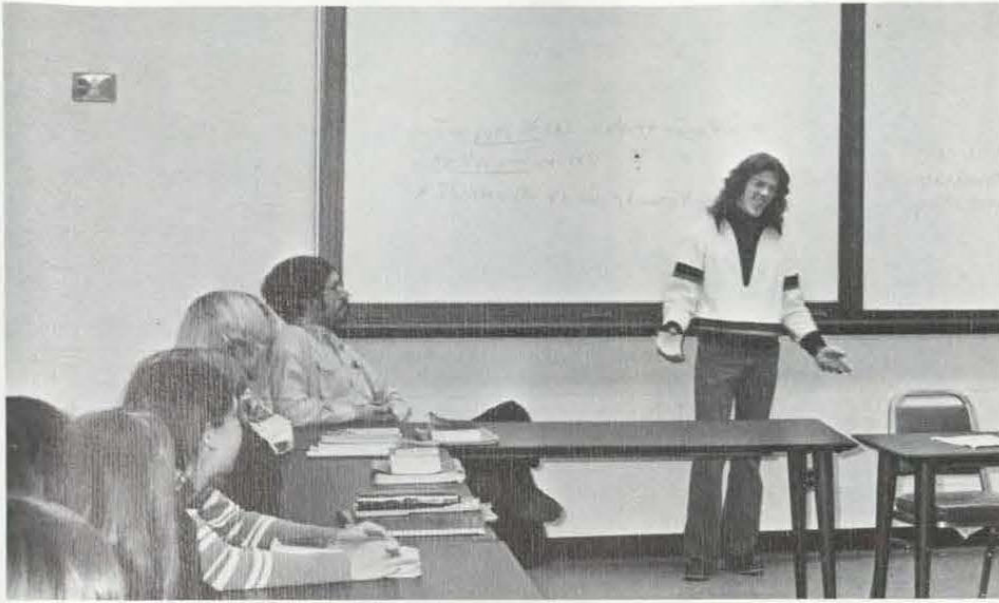

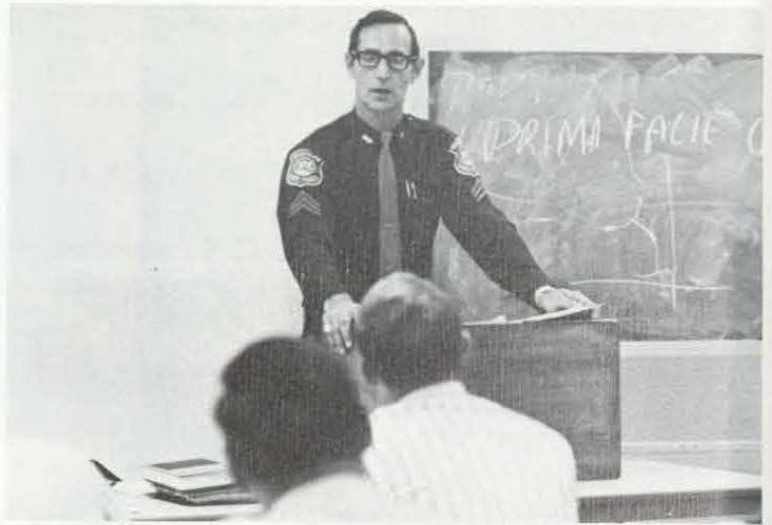

College education for prison inmates, management development, skill training, educational conferences, law enforcement training . . . each year the list grows as the Division of Continuing Education and Extension adds to the roster of its activities.

As a special service to Upper Peninsula schools, Continuing Education helps develop community school programs and bus driver training. This fall an educational conference, known as the Innovations Fair, was opened to the schools to allow a free exchange of new teaching concepts.

The School of Banking was established in 1964 and its courses have now assumed an important role in banking education and personnel training. The department of General Studies, also offered by the Division, provides experience and training in such fields as Medical and X-ray technology and broadcasting, and a medical secretary program. Further classes, as a part of a law enforcement program, provide the basis for police training.

In joint effort with the State Division of Vocational Education and the Employment Security Commission, the Northern Michigan Skill Center provides a variety of vocational training classes. These programs are designed to train underemployed and unemployed persons in fields of work that will fit the needs of business and industry in this region.

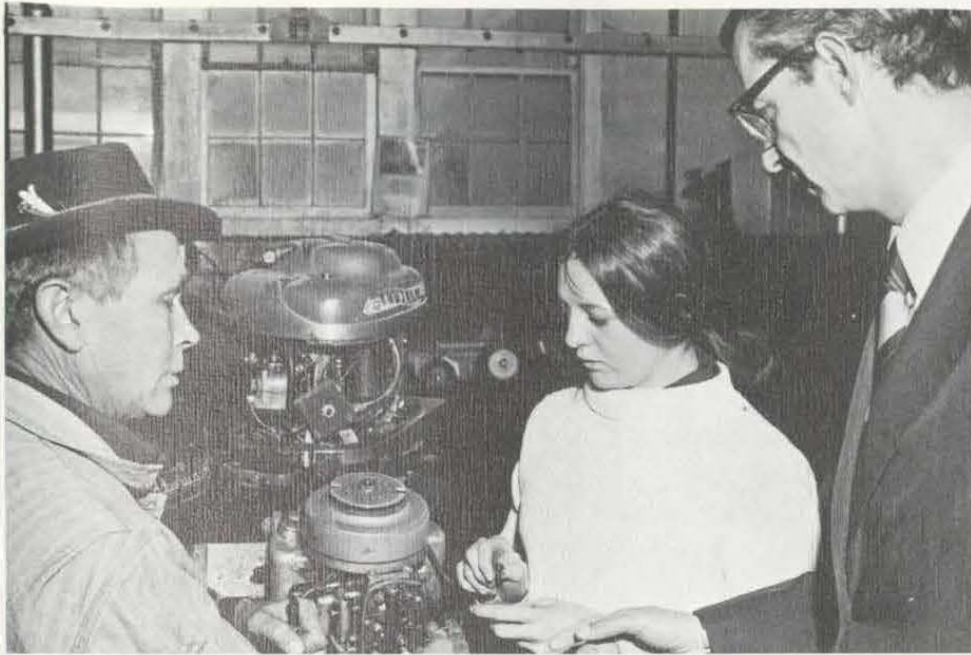

## School of Education

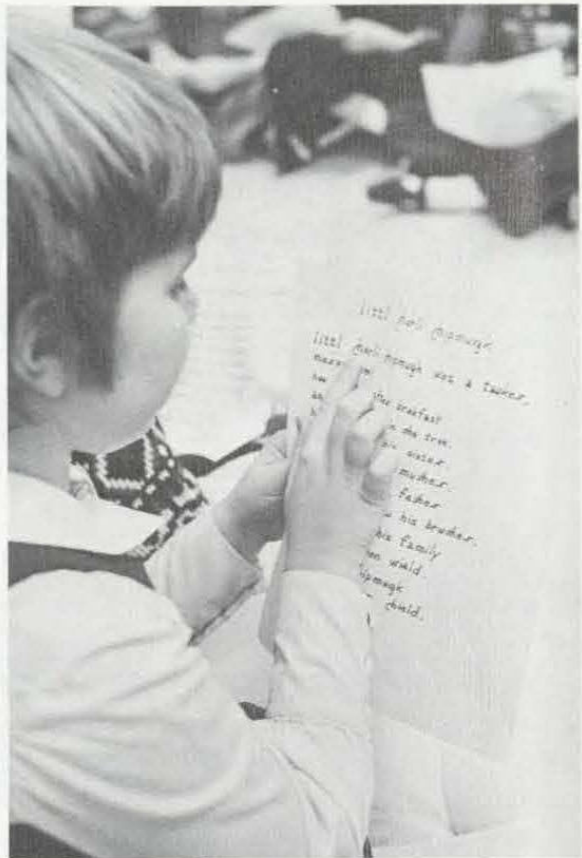
The School of Education offers a wide diversity of programs in conjunction with various departments throughout the university.

A major part of the School's curriculum consists of preparing students for careers as elementary or secondary teachers, or teachers of the mentally handicapped. A teaching certificate may also be earned in the field of Health, Physical Education, and Recreation.

Several related services are provided by the School. A Curriculum Materials Center is operated by the university library and the School maintains a Selective Admission policy for aspiring future teachers. Experience in student teaching is also provided and required.

Included in the School are the departments of Home Economics, Industry and Technology, and Library Science. Under the approval of the State's Division of Vocational Education, the Home Economics department prepares teachers for Home Economics, Consumer, and Family Life Education positions. Students may also prepare to enter the American Dietetic Association, the American School Food Service Association, or the American Restaurant Association. The department of Industry and Technology prepares students for several options. They may choose careers in Industrial or vocational education, supervisory positions in industry and building, or Traffic Safety education.

The department of psychology is also included in the School of Education. The undergraduate major is designed to introduce the student to research methodology and to provide basic understandings in the scientific study of behavior.

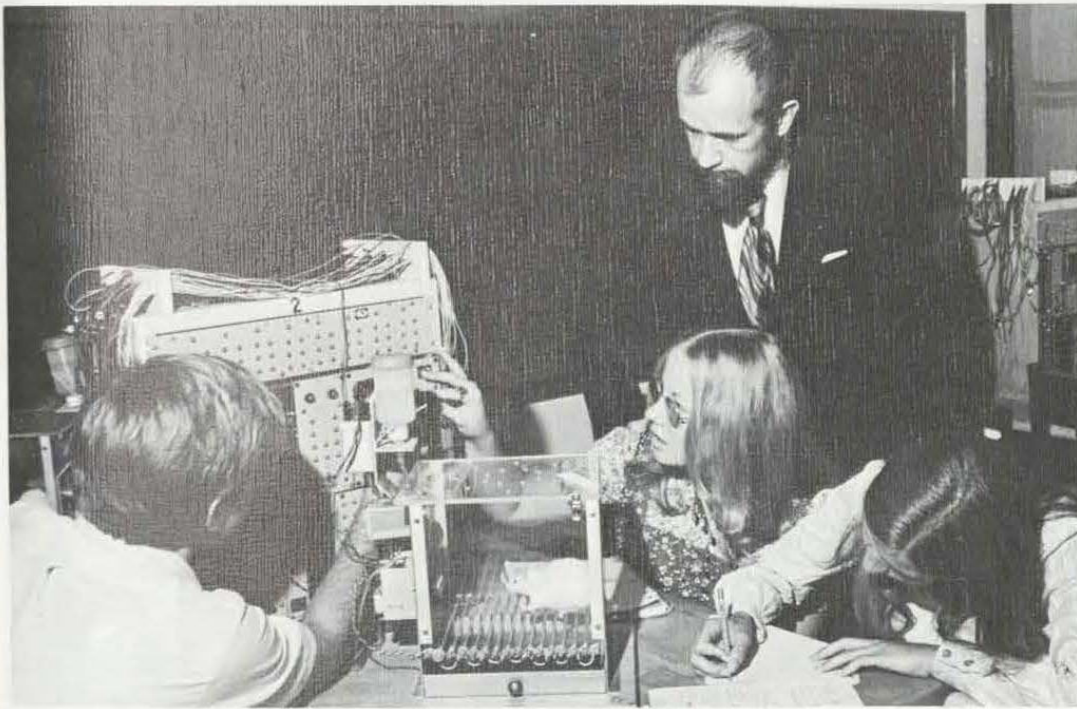

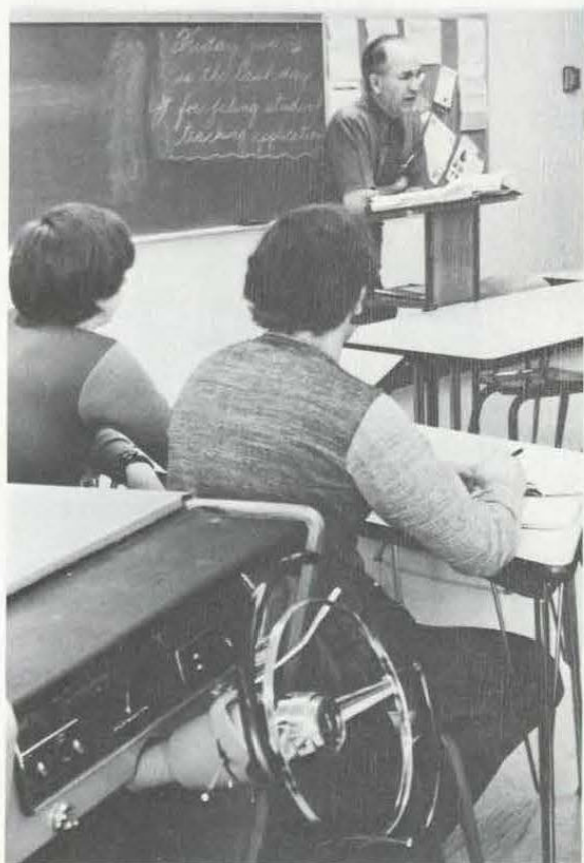
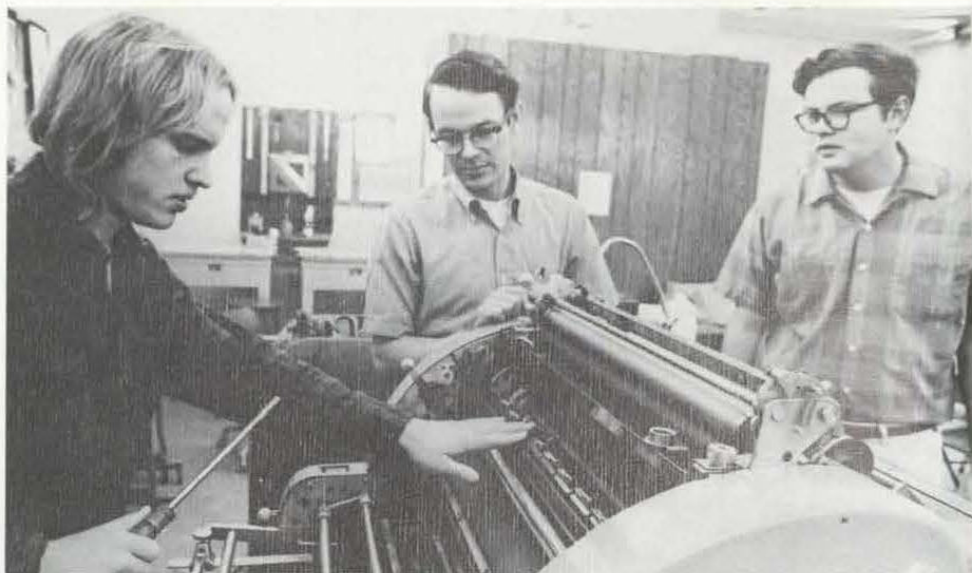

## *School of Business*

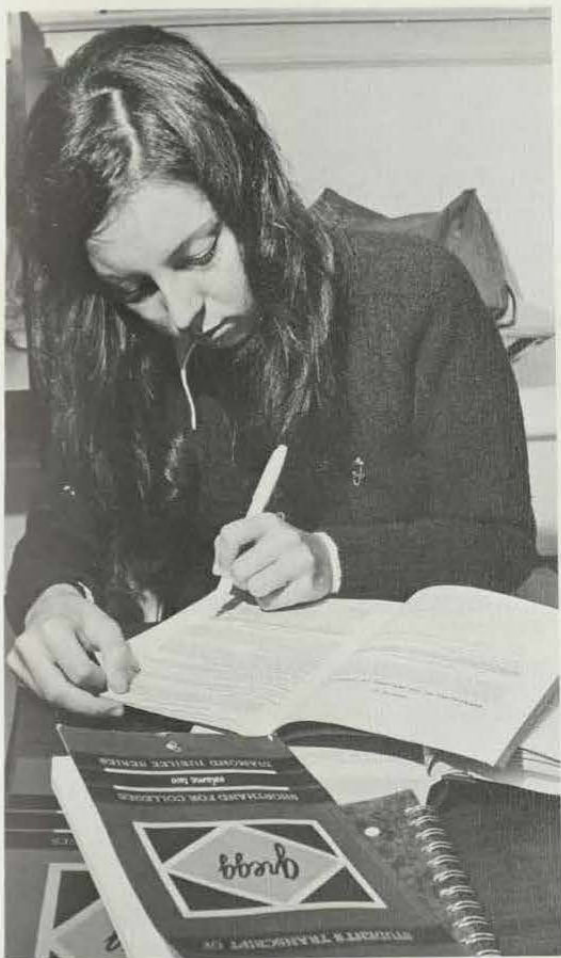
The three departments of Accounting and Finance, Business Education, and Management and Marketing, compose the basic framework of the School of Business.

Curriculum in the Business Administration category (Accounting, and Finance, Management and Marketing) is designed for those students pursuing a baccalaureate degree for application to careers in business, government, private, and non-profit institutions. Students learn the necessary skills that will enable them to become influential in planning, organizing, operating, and controlling a business enterprise. Accounting and Finance majors may center their training around general, industrial or public accounting, or financial management. Management and Marketing majors may opt to concentrate on marketing, personnel, or production management.

The four-year curriculum in Business Education prepares students to teach vocational high school courses which lead to office and distributive occupations. A MA in Education with an emphasis on Business is also available through this program.

In addition, the School offers several special business programs. Students may complete a one-year secretarial course or a two year, Associate degree program in the accounting, general business, retailing and sales, or secretarial fields.



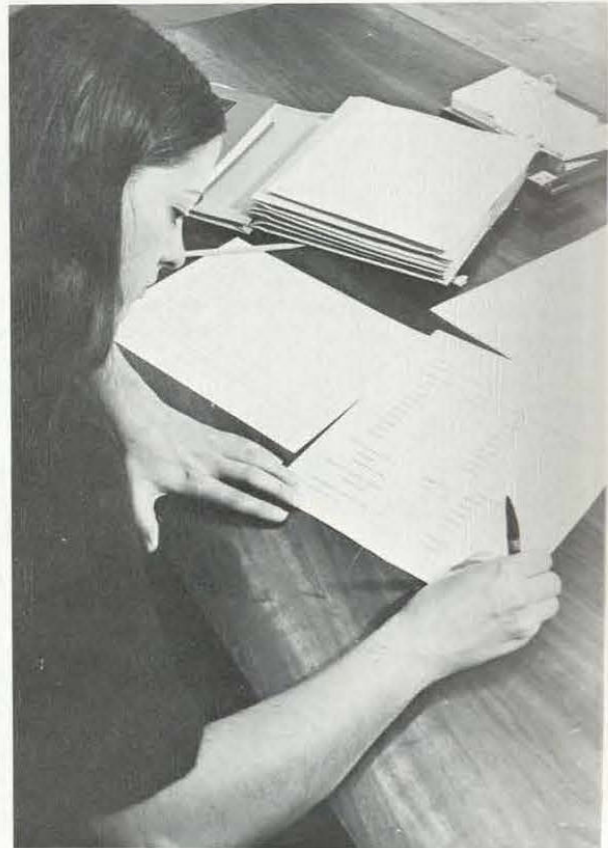

## School of Nursing

The basic goal of the School of Nursing is to prepare the student to plan and implement comprehensive health care programs for all ages and in a variety of settings. A Bachelor of Science degree is obtained from the School through both professional and general education courses. These classes provide the knowledge and clinical practice required for students to offer efficient, up-to-date nursing care. They also prepare students for staff positions in hospitals and community and public health agencies. Two programs are offered in the field of Nursing. One, the four-year program, leads to a BS degree and examination for licensure as a Registered Nurse. The other, a three semester program, is provided for students wishing to become Practical Nurses.

Early this fall the department of Speech Pathology and Audiology was added to the School. This action was taken in the hopes that eventually the entire School of Nursing will be consolidated to include not only Speech Pathology, but also the medical and X-ray technology programs and allied health programs now under development. Students entering the Speech Pathology and Audiology program may earn a Master's degree to obtain full certification or may elect to work for a teaching certificate. Clinical experience is provided in Northern's Speech and Hearing Clinic and by summer internship at Bay Cliff Health Camp.

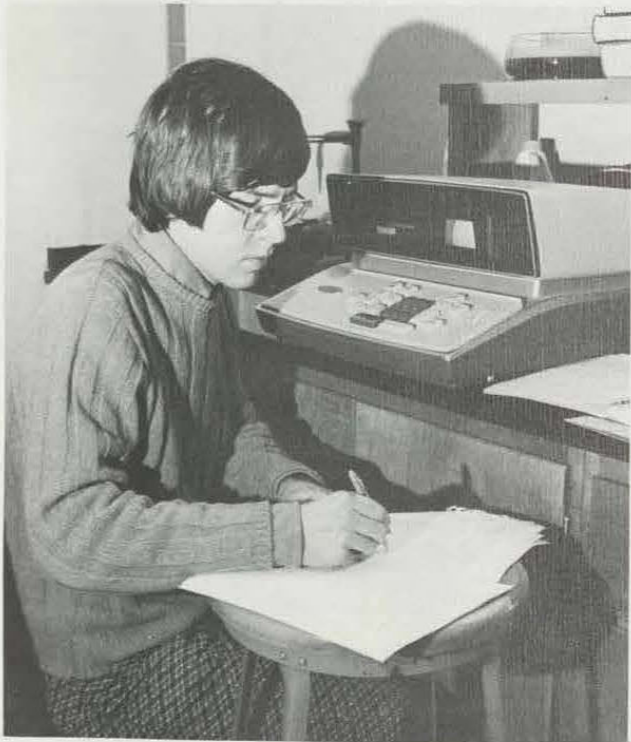
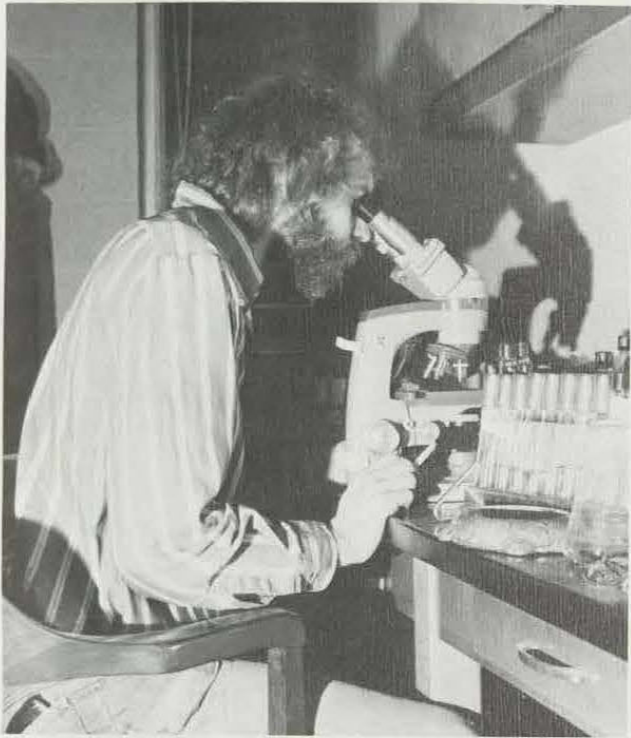
## *The School of Graduate Studies*

Although Northern began to offer graduate level courses in 1938, it was not until 1960 that the School of Graduate Studies was established. The present program now confers a Master of Arts degree in the fields of Biology, Chemistry, Education, English, Geography, History, Mathematics, and Speech Pathology. A Master of Science degree is also available in the field of Accounting.

Applicants for graduate studies, according to their prior education and present objectives, are placed in either degree, non-degree, or unclassified categories. In order to be admitted to the degree program, the student is usually required to hold a minimum GPA of 2.5. If the student cannot meet the GPA admission requirement, he may enter the School in a non-degree status. After completing twelve hours of graduate study and attaining a 3.0 GPA, the student may petition to be classified at degree level. The unclassified category is established for those students wishing to take graduate credit strictly for furthering their personal studies.

Northern's graduate students are active in many facets of university activity. Often, these students assist in the teaching of the Liberal Studies science labs as well as several other laboratory experience classes offered by many of the departments. Graduate students are also active in several State and Federally funded research programs being carried out by the University.





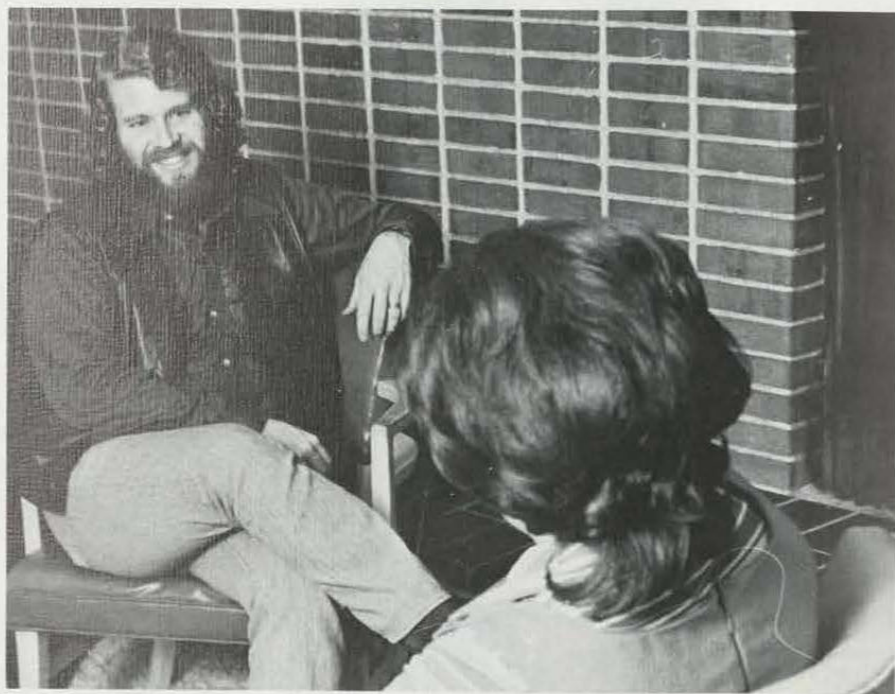
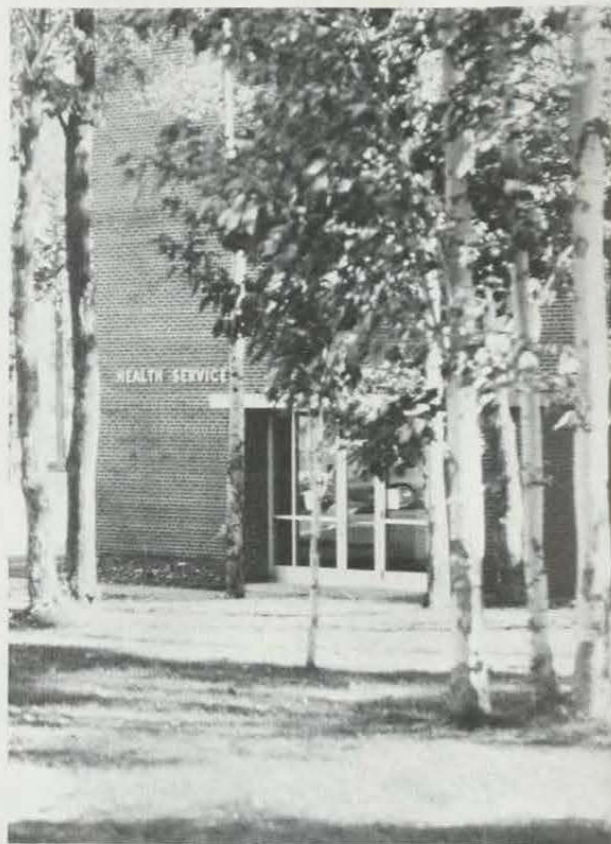
## *Student Aid Provided by Health Center, Security, Counseling*

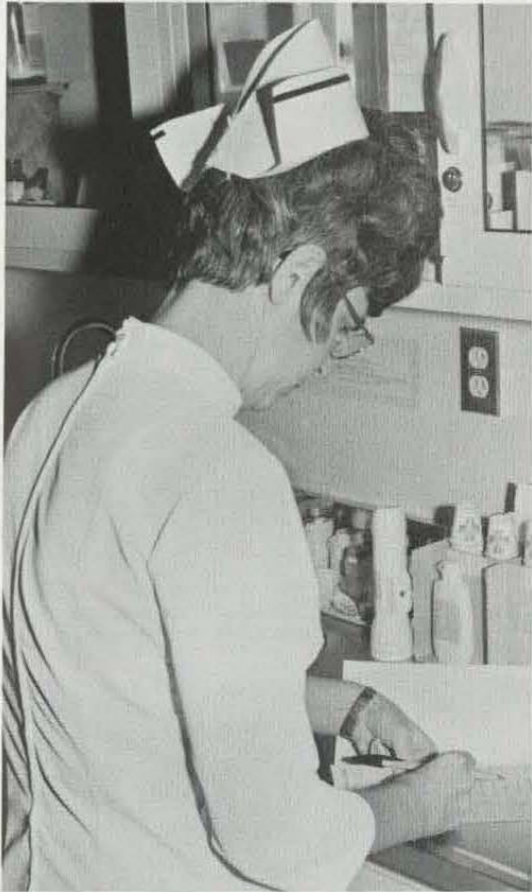
Among the several student services offered in the university community are those of the Security, Counseling, and Health Center departments.

The fourteen member staff of Campus Security is headed by Chief William R. Lyons. Included in their many duties are investigations of reports of loss or theft, gun registration and storage, law enforcement, motor vehicle regulation, and emergency ambulance services. Before being hired, officers are required to have some college education and, if they will be enforcing state laws, to have successfully completed a 256 hour basic police training course.

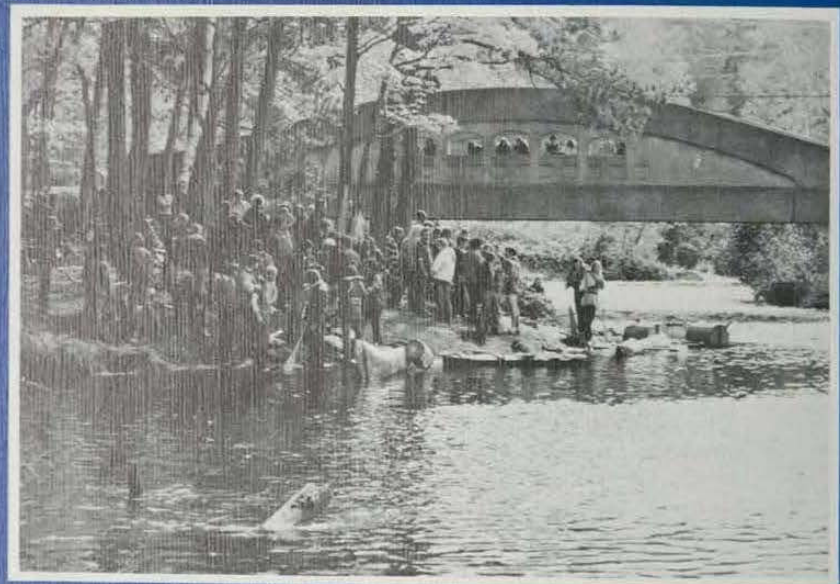
Vocational and educational counseling, personal counseling, and psychological and consultant services are offered by the Counseling Center. Headed by associate professor John Russell, the center's staff maintain a vocational information file, administer aptitude and qualifying exams, and counsel individual students.

Under the directorship of Dr. Barbara Lyons, a staff consisting of three full time physicians and ten registered nurses service the university Health Center. The Center operates an outpatient clinic and a twelve bed infirmary. Lecture series and discussion groups, such as the birth control seminar given by Dr. Lyons this fall, are also sponsored by the clinic.

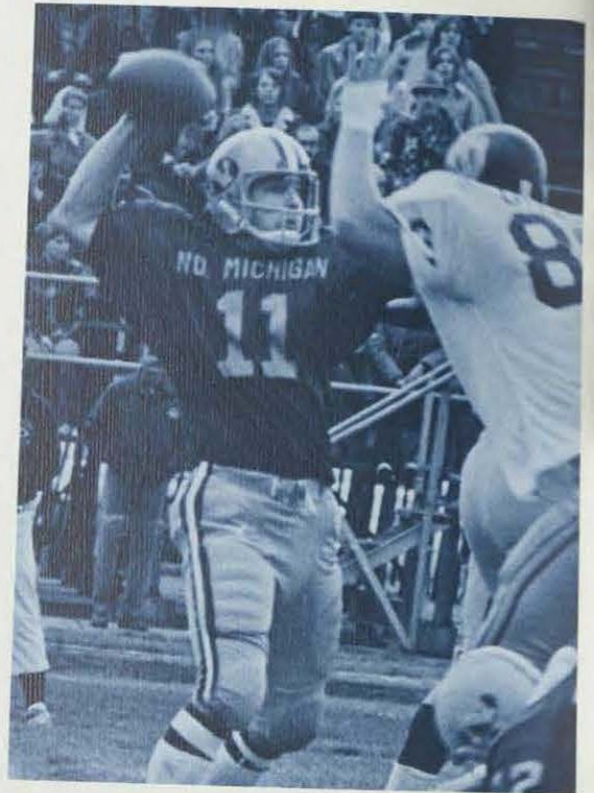
## Gridders Experience Disappointing Season

With the experience gained by this year's gridders, it is hopeful that the Wildcats' 1973 co-captains John Engel and Jim Rathje's team will improve next season's record.





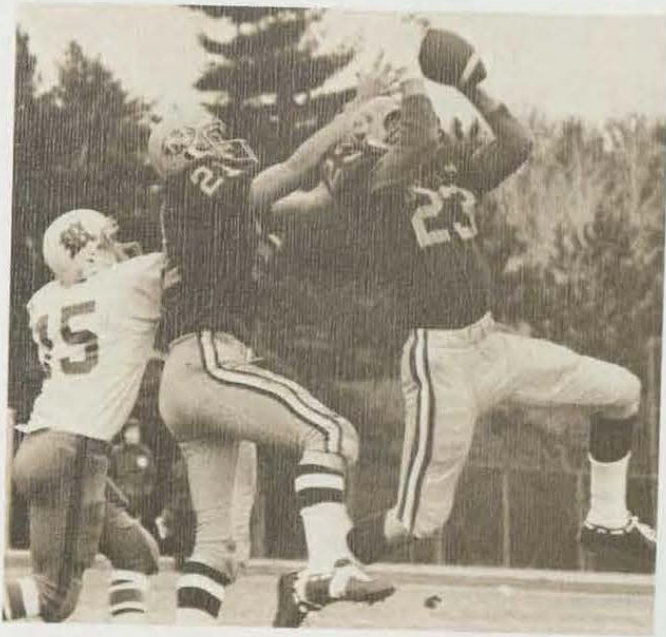
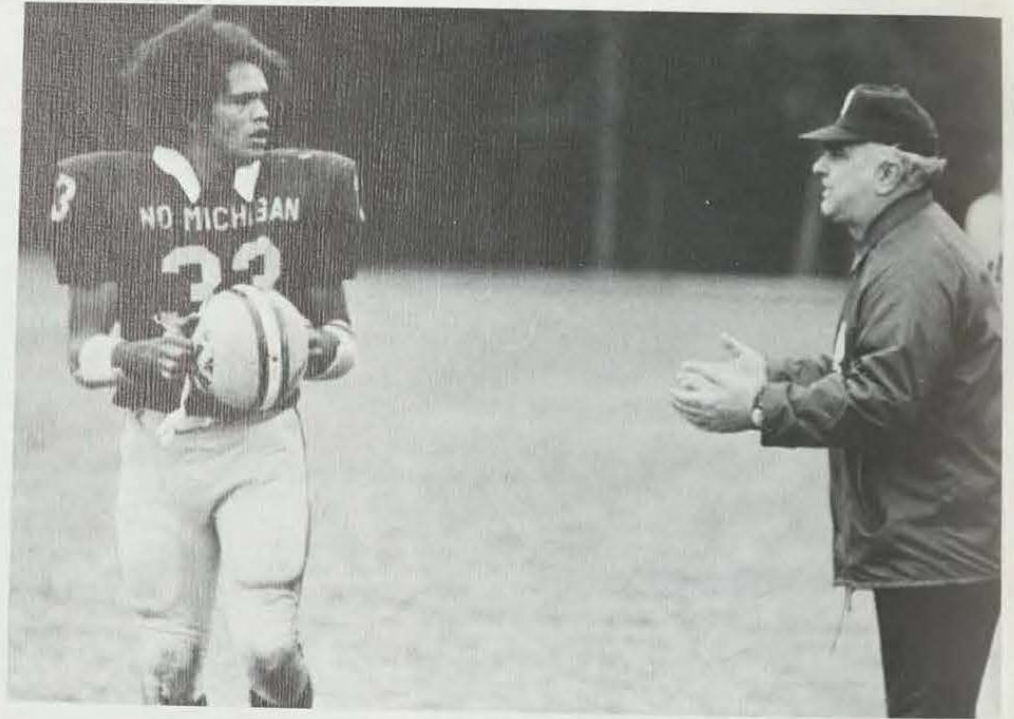
