

The Marquette County Board of Commissioners met as a Committee of the Whole for the 1990 Budget Hearings and Budget Work Sessions all held in Room 231 of the Henry A. Skewis Annex, Marquette, MI.

Monday, August 27, 1990 - 3:00 p.m.

Chairperson Corkin opened the Committee of the Whole Budget Hearings and called the meeting to order. Present: Comm. Arsenault, Comm. Bays, Comm. DeFant, Comm. Seppanen and Comm. Corkin. Absent: None. Also Present: County Administrator, Dennis Aloia, and Gary Yoder, Finance Manager.

Administrator Aloia reviewed his 1991 General Fund budget recommendations, summarized changes to requested amounts to the General Fund budget, and reviewed the 1991 Capital Improvements Program budget recommendations.

Administrator Aloia also requested Commissioners keep a list of particular budget items if they wish to consider increasing or decreasing the recommended budgeted amount. These items can then be summarized and used during the budget work sessions as a starting point for changes in the Administrator's recommendations, leading to the final Committee of the Whole budget recommendation.
