Biography

Herbert W. Corey, son of Mr. and Mrs. Homer Corey, was born in Stephenson Township in the year of 1909. He was reared on a farm and attended the public schools in the Village of Stephenson. He graduated from the Stephenson High School in 1928 and from the Central States School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin in 1952. He attended many banking seminars.

Mr. Corey married Miss Myrtle Pecotte in 1930. They have five daughters; namely, Mrs. Anne Hulsizer, Iron Mountain, Mrs. Marilyn Parcels, Iron River, Mrs. Carol Hoida, Menominee, Mrs. Karen Zwergel, Grand Rapids, and Kristin Corey at home. They have nine grandchildren.

Mr. Corey was employed by the Bank of Stephenson in 1929. He was appointed Cashier in 1946 and President of the Bank in 1949. During his tenure as President the bank assets have increased from \$2,188,298 to \$8,935,000. He was elected President of the Michigan Bankers Association in 1962 and is presently serving on its Council. He was elected Vice President of the American Bankers Association for 1968-1969.
