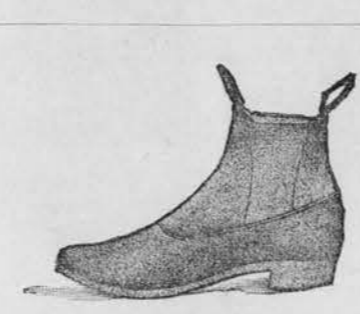

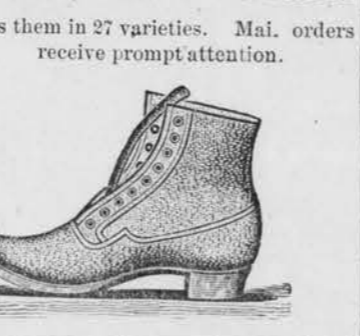

AN AQUEDUCT FIND
A Couple of Ishpeming Mines Con- tending Against a Sudden Flow of Water.
Chief Routhier Is — Marshal Scully's Resig- nation A Welcomed Pay Day—New Drug Store for Ishpeming

Too Much Water.
Last Thursday night a large body of water was struck by miners in the west end of the Lake Angeline mine, and although the pumps were worked to their fullest capacity the water was steadily gaining up to the latest advices yesterday. Where it comes from is something of a mystery, although the most plausible and generally accepted hypothesis is that it has its source in the swamp overlying part of the Lake Angeline and Section 16 mines.
It is almost certain that the Section 16 mine of the Lake Superior Iron com- pany will be "drowned" with water as well as the Lake Angeline, as their underground workings are connected. The pumps have been kept busily at work, but apparently without keeping the oncoming body of water from gain- ing on them. Efforts will be made to confine the water to as small a part of the mine as possible, and to hold it in check until the flood abates.

Fire Department Election.
The special meeting of the entire fire department called for Saturday evening last at the central station was well at- tended, nearly a hundred firemen being present.
Hon. Henry Routhier was elected chief of the department, to succeed John P. Outhwaite, resigned, by an unanimous vote. For assistant chief of the department formerly held by Mr. Routhier, John E. Tibor was elected. A vote of thanks was passed to Mr. Outhwaite for his valuable services, when the meeting adjourned.

Will Resign.
At the next meeting of the common council, on Wednesday evening, De- cember 17th, which will be the last reg- ular meeting for the year 1890, Mr. M. C. Scully, the city marshal, will hand in his resignation, as on the first of January he will assume the duties of the more important office of sheriff of Marquette county. It will then be nec- essary for the council to select a new marshal. Among the candidates for the office are Deputy Marshal Gust Petersen, Patrolman Charles J. Johnson and Mr. Michael Shea.
It is possible that the council will not immediately select a successor to Mr. Scully, allowing the duties of the office to be filled by the next officer in rank, Deputy Marshal Petersen.

Mr. Scully will leave the office of marshal to take that of sheriff with the hearty good will and respect of every- one in the city. For the past four years he has filled the office in a manner highly creditable to himself, and most satisfactory to the public. There can be no doubt that he will discharge the duties of his new office in a manner fully as acceptable.

Pay Day.
The real importance of pay day was never more clearly understood, and that wished for day was never more eagerly longed for, in Ishpeming than at present. The three weeks strike in October made money scarce, then the "financial stringency" got in its deadly work in the east, and business was dull and collections poor last week simply because there was twenty-five cents in cash in circulation where there should have been a dollar. This is pay week, when nearly all of the important mines will disburse the wages for a full month's work. The money will come very handy, to miners and business men both.

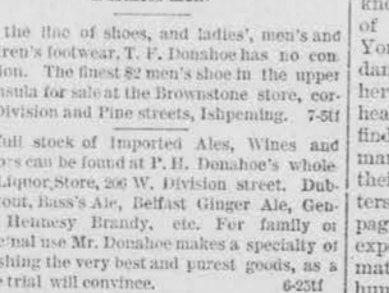

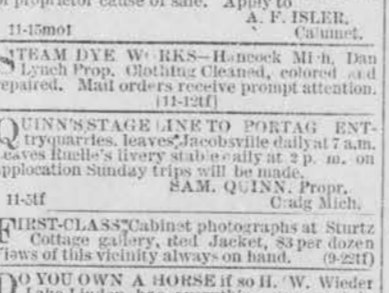
