MARINE GOSSIP. Unfounded Charge of Delay in Unloading Coal at Portage Lake Docks.

The Detroit Free Press of Saturday contained the following account of the steamer H. B. Tuttle, which finished unloading Saturday at the Mineral Range dock: "Somebody will have to settle for the time lost by boats that took coal to Portage Lake during the past few weeks."

The steamer Tuttle arrived at Hancock only to find a number of other boats ahead of her, hence the delay. However, the statement that it is a common thing for coal boats to be hung up a week at Portage lake is not true, but an exception to the usual order of things, and then shippers have often been to blame.

The cold snap of the past few days has had the effect of giving navigation a severe setback on Portage lake, and should it continue several boats will winter here. Yesterday morning Portage lake was well covered with ice, varying in thickness from one to three inches.
