ATTRACTIONS OF DULUTH. "The Zenith City of the Unsalted Seas." STREETS.—The retail business houses are mostly located on Superior St. The streets above this, running parallel are numbered from First up. AND THIS A "TOP-NOTCHER." In a resume of the mines of Montana The Inter Mountain of Butte recently referred to the Butte & Boston as one of a group of which the state has reason to be proud. Well, may be so, but not judging from the following from the Boston News Bureau:

SLIMLY ATTENDED. The wrestling match at Italian Hall, Calumet, Saturday evening, between Ed Brookington of Iron Mountain and William Martin fell flat as a business proposition.
