The necessity for the harbor of refuge being constructed at the Portage Lake canal was again made forcibly apparent during the storm of the past few days.

Wednesday afternoon the steam barge Garden City, with the schooners Verona and James King as her consorts, which had finished unloading at Portage Lake ports, started for the head of the lake and passed out of the canal at 6 o'clock p. m.

The Garden City secured an entrance in safety and took shelter at Lilly Pond. But the vessels were less fortunate and were left at the mercy of the terrible storm.

The Verona was built in Cleveland in 1873, and is rated A2. Her gross tonnage is 728, and the owner is Alex Gilchrist of Vermilion, Ohio.
