ANOTHER POLICEMAN PUT ON. HOUGHTON COUNCIL ARRANGES FOR THE BETTER PROTECTION OF THE BUSINESS DISTRICT.

The objectionable class that seem to make Houghton their headquarters came up for attention at the meeting of the village council Thursday evening.

As is usual of late, considerable business relating to contemplated improvements came up. A petition was received from Rev. A. J. Rezek, asking that a drainage system be dug under the basement of the new St. Ignatius church.

FEEL THE LABOR SHORTAGE.

CONTRACTORS ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT IMPROVEMENTS BADLY HAMPERED IN THE WORK.

Colonel Barlow, division engineer for the northwestern states, with headquarters in New York, accompanied by Major Clinton B. Sears of Duluth, arrived at Houghton Thursday morning on a tour of inspection of the government improvement work now under way.

Mr. Barlow expressed himself as highly pleased with the manner in which the work is being carried on, and with Major Sears, left in the evening for Marquette, boarding the eastbound train at Chassel.
