THE U. P. BUSINESS CONVENTION. Mr. Tim Nester, chairman of the committee charged with the duty of seeing it that the various counties of the upper peninsula are represented in the convention to be held at Ishpeming the coming fall, some days since received the following communication from Hon. H. W. Seymour, of Sault Ste. Marie:

SAULT STE. MARIE, Mich., Aug. 15, 1885. Hon. T. NESTER: Dear Sir:—The St. Mary's Falls canal committee will not be ready to report as early as the date now fixed for the meeting of the U. P. convention.

IN accordance with Mr. Seymour's suggestion, and after consultation with several of those who actively interested themselves in the work of the June convention, Mr. Nester has fixed on the first Tuesday of October, being the 6th day of that month, as the date on which the convention will be held, instead of September 8th.

WE present, in this connection, the report adopted by the Detroit board of trade, referred to in Mr. Seymour's letter: THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE appointed July 15 to prepare a statement expressive of the views of the board of trade relative to certain improvements in the channel of the St. Mary's river reported as follows:

THE completion of the Northern Pacific railway, extending from Duluth to the Pacific, and of the Canadian Pacific railway, from Lake Superior to the Red River country, traversing thousands of miles of fertile territory just beginning to be developed, promises, with a certainty of an early fulfillment, to pour into the Lake Superior trade within the near future an amount of traffic in grain, beef, lumber and the products of the mine and the soil, to be transported via our water routes, beyond all limits that can at present be estimated.

THE association, therefore, most heartily recommends the speedy completion of all improvements in the St. Mary's river necessary to supply easy and complete transportation for the trade of Lake Superior and tributary territory. Among these we would urge the immediate completion of the Hay Lake channel in the St. Mary's river, saving thereby about twelve miles in the distance between Lakes Superior and Huron.

WE reaffirm the declarations of the national democratic party at its last convention on the subject of the tariff, and especially do we maintain that the necessary reduction in taxation can and must be effected without depriving American labor of the ability to compete successfully with foreign labor, and without imposing lower rates of duty than will be ample to cover any increased cost of production which may exist in consequence of the higher rate of wages existing in this country.
