WALL STREET STOCKS.

New York, Feb. 20.-Dread of the unknown was a depressing factor in the stock market today, and preparations evidently were being made for the termination of three consecutive holidays by the lightning of speculative trades.

The speculative world seems to have arrived at the conclusion that the completion of the details of the steel market is not likely to be followed immediately by a campaign of manipulation for higher prices in order to make a market for the new securities.

In the principal active railroad stocks there were at one time declines of 1 to 2 points, members of the group, Southern and Pacific groups being notably affected.

The local traction stocks were bid up in the course of an attempt against the shorts, and the stocks of a number of the smaller railroad companies were lifted 1 to 2 points.
