MINING NEWS. MASS ADDING MORE MINERS. Operations Being Pushed at the Property—Much Heavy Copper.

BETTER PRICES DUE FOR COPPER. Commenting upon the copper situation at the present time and the size of the new investment on hand on the first of the year, the American Metal Market says:

"The law of supply and demand that caused an accumulation of copper during 1901 and 1902 is now working steadily toward a balancing of the account. The increased production, going on at a rate of 10 per cent per annum, should be more than overtaken during 1903 by the increase in consumption and the price should gradually advance to a point somewhere between thirteen and fourteen cents.

MINING GOSSIP. Copper at London yesterday was 6s 3d lower with spot at £52 18s 9d and futures at £53, 5s, but the New York market continued practically unchanged.

The Hudson River Waterpower company has purchased the American Steel & Wire company one million pounds of the largest size copper wire at under thirteen cents per pound.

John Stanton says: "The stock of copper continues to shrink and there is nothing in sight to change the situation. In my opinion, the production of copper ten years hence will be double what it is at present.

Utah's copper output in 1902 amounted to 29,375,780 pounds, which at an average price of 11.50 cents per pound, represented a total value of \$3,368,215. This shows a falling off of 900,746 pounds, compared with the preceding year, and a reduction of \$1,170,830 in the value.

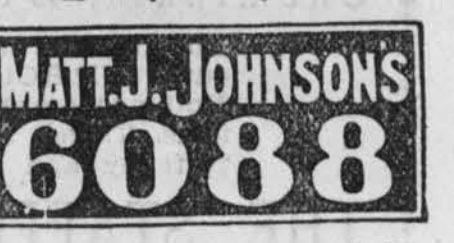
