AMALGAMATED ENJOINED.

New York Court Grants Plea of MacGinniss in Montana Case.

In New York Thursday, John MacGinniss obtained an injunction restraining the Boston & Montana Consolidated Copper & Silver Mining Company and others from making any disposition of any property of the corporation.

It is apparent that Mr. MacGinniss is not satisfied with the decision of the supreme court of Montana had virtually ended all litigation as far as the dividend question of the Boston & Montana is concerned.
