WILBUR WRIGHT ADDS TO HIS FAME

With Business in Much of Manhattan Practically at a Standstill the Dayton Aviator Achieves

Sailing Up the Hudson to Point Well Above Grant's Tomb and Then Turning Gracefully in Midair and Shooting Back to Governor's Island, Landing There Without a Mishap, He Crowns Big Celebration With a Spectacular Flight.

New York, Oct. 4.4-An aeroplan flashed by the white dome of Grant's tomb today and, turning gracefully in umdair ever the Hudson river, shot back to Covernor's island, ten miles away. Wilbur Wright thus placed his name in the rank with Hudson and Fulton in one of the most spectacular feats of aviation yet recorded.

Over masses of warships, from whos deeks the hoarse cheers of the sailors were borne up to him. Wright flew to twenty miles' round trip, remaining the air thirty three minutes and thirty three seconds, alighting at the acrodromic without a mishap,






