The recent finds of graphite promise to be of great value and there is a possibility that the range will become better known for its graphite than for its iron. Some of the samples recently assayed contain 52.83 percent in graphite, an unusually high percentage, as graphite found in many other parts of the country do not average much above 15 percent.

Among those who have extensive graphite deposits is Thomas Feigh of Duluth, a former resident of Ishpeming, who has had drills run at one locality last week run through a deposit fifty feet in depth.

STOCKING ORE.

Volunteer Co. Will Have Good-Sized Stockpile By Spring.

The Volunteer Ore company, which a year ago began to open up a mine on the Cascade range, is making excellent headway.

The machinery at the Volunteer shaft is over 300 feet deep and the shaft is now being worked on several levels. Over 100 men are on the payroll and the force will be increased as rapidly as additional men can be worked to advantage underground.

The company is making some improvements at the dam at Palmer lake, so that it will take care of the extra water that will accumulate in the spring.
