









### Quinnell To Give Lincoln Day Message

A Lincoln Day message will be delivered by George C. Quinnell, of Marquette, in an address over WDMJ, the Mining Journal radio station, tomorrow evening, beginning at 5:45. It will be the fifteenth of a series of "Speak Up For Democracy" programs sponsored by the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Quinnell is a major in the Michigan state troops, in charge of companies in Marquette, Escanaba and Sault Ste. Marie.

Announcement of the address was made yesterday by Francis

Mathews, VFW post commander, who emphasized the similarity of circumstances prevailing today with those which confronted Lincoln when he became the sixteenth president of the United States.

**Liberty in Jeopardy**

"If he were alive today, Abraham Lincoln would warn the American people to strive for victory by making the United States a glorious example of true democracy at work," Mathews said.

"Just as in his time, the basic principles of human liberty are again in jeopardy, America is engaged in a 'worldwide civil war' between those who believe in individual liberty and those who would destroy human rights.

"We believe our leaders today are echoing the same words that Lincoln would voice if he were in the White House," Mathews said. "Lincoln fought to preserve our unity when our people were divided on the question of human rights. Lincoln believed in the dignity of

man and the principle that all men are created equal."

The VFW "Speak Up for Democracy" program was started in December, 1940, under the direction of the National Department of Americanism of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. They are being presented by local VFW leaders to the radio public in cooperation with nearly 460 radio stations.

**Murphy Denies He Tried To Become Contact Man**

WASHINGTON, Feb. 9.—P—Members of the House military affairs committee investigating national defense activities today heard Lieut.-Gov. Frank Murphy, of Michigan, deny assertions of officials of a Muskegon, Mich., firm that he suggested the company employ him as a contact man and pay him a salary to obtain war contracts.

The company officials who testified were S. B. Withington, general works manager, and E. E. Widlers, plant superintendent of the Brunswick-Balke-Coller company. They told the committee Murphy and E. E. Clapp, of Detroit, had sought employment in negotiating war orders.

Questioned by the committee, commander of Knights Templar here.

Murphy shouted, "I am lieutenant-governor of Michigan and could not live in Washington," added that "I have no personal influence in Washington."

The committee hearing was called after Rep. Engel (R-Mich) had told the House Murphy sought to share in contract commissions.

Murphy told the committee today he accompanied Clapp to the Muskegon company's office last November solely to help Clapp obtain a position as the company's representative in Washington, and added he would be of service to any other person or institution in Michigan regardless of location."

**Priority Rating for Police Radio Equipment Sought**

LANSING, Feb. 9.—P—Priority rating for materials needed in construction of a two-way frequency modulation radio system for the Michigan state police today was requested by Governor Van Wagener.

At the same time, Capt. C. J. Seavarda, chief of the state police communications division, left for Washington to explain the need for the equipment, purchase of which was authorized by the legislature in its recent special session.

In a letter to the War Production Board, the Governor described two-way radio communication between police headquarters and cruiser units as "essential to efficient police work."

"Indeed, experiments by our Michigan state police with two-way frequency modulation radio equipment first demonstrated its value

to our military forces," Van Wagener wrote. He said the equipment would prove a weapon against sabotage, subversive activities and other threats to war production.

**Legion To Have Active Role in Civil Defense**

LANSING, Feb. 9.—P—Governor Van Wagener today assured Herman F. Luhrs, of Flint, state commander of the American Legion, that the Legion henceforth would have a more active role in civilian defense affairs.

The veteran organization has been irked because it was not called on for spectacular efforts in establishing protective services, and its feelings were given voice in the January special session of the legislature by Rep. Colin L. Smith, Republican, Big Rapids.

Van Wagener, at a press conference in Luhrs' presence, said "the policy will be the same, but the re-

sults may be different," in assigning members of the Legion to civilian duties. He said this meant taking more veterans into defense posts, such as air raid wardenships.

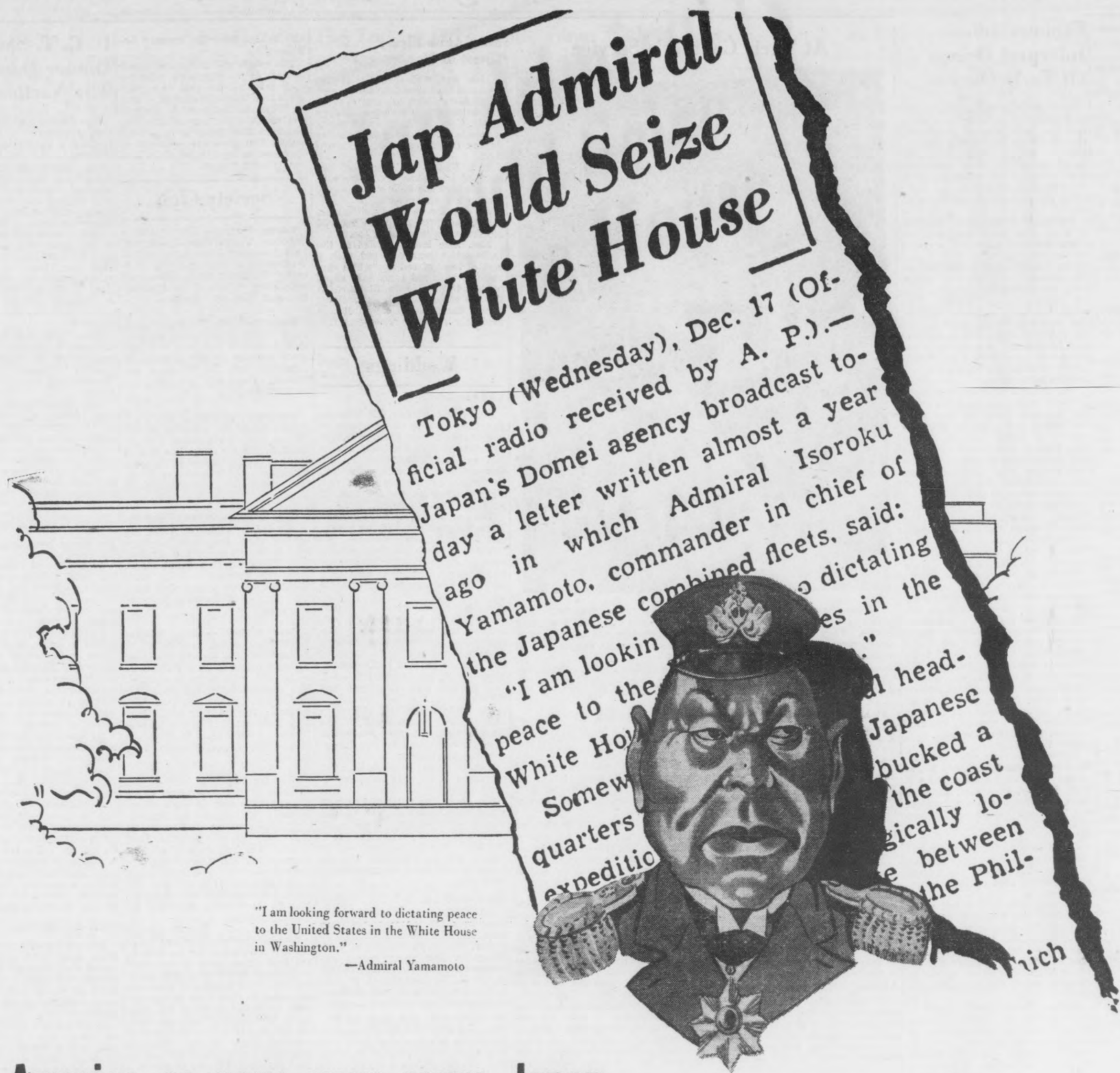
