

Today, when the ethics of technology and science are being seriously questioned, even by the people they are supposed to benefit, it is imperative that we do not permit the destruction of other and possibly alternative cultures, some of which, especially that of the North American Indians, have existed for untold centuries.

They had no need of nuclear weapons, penitentiaries, mental institutions or 'homes' for orphans and the aged. White propaganda and brainwashing (a la Hollywood) have portrayed the Indians as barbarous savages. When we consider our polluted rivers, earth and sky, our congested cities, economic stresses and strains, discredited religious and political systems, it is a mute question as to who is truly the savage – red man or white man!

The aims of the ONAWAY TRUST is to render all possible aid to the proud remnants of the Indian nations who are desperately struggling for both physical and spiritual survival in their OWN land.
