## NOTICE OF CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGE

NOTE: The word "aspects" in the first line of Amendment No. 1 to the Constitution of the Organization of North American Indian Students of Northern Michigan University, which was approved by the general membership via mail ballot on June 23, 1972, should have read "assets". This was a typographical error.

Insofar as the basic meaning of the amendment was not altered by the use of the incorrect word, it has not been judged necessary to call for another vote on the amendment.

Therefore, with the Power of Attorney vested in me by the Organization of North American Indian Students, I hereby authorize that the correction in wording be made so that the amendment (otherwise unchanged from that voted upon) shall read as follows:

"In the event of dissolution, all assets, real and personal, shall be distributed to such organizations as are qualified as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provisions of a future United States Internal Revenue Code."
