Mr. Frank Senger, publisher of the Manistique Pioneer-Tribune visited the Nishnawbe News office Friday, and delivered a quotation on printing the paper, which had been requested by the Nishnawbe News staff.

You will note by the attached quotation that the Manistique firm can print the paper at a considerable savings over that presently expended in Gladstone.

The Nishnawbe News staff has decided to change its paper to a full size or 'broad sheet' format, with eight pages. This can be printed in Manistique for approximately the same price as the eight-page tabloid was done in Gladstone, and--in effect--providing the same space as 16 of the tabloid pages. (Forty-five dollars has to be added to the cost of each broad-sheet page for composition costs, over and above that quoted in the enclosed communication.)

In a telephone conversation this morning with Mr. Senger, he said that the paper can be printed without a formal year's contract as stated in the quotation letter. However, he would like some assurance from ONAIS that they would continue the job with his company for reasons which are obvious, regarding his own staffing and equipment use. He understands that ONAIS can take their paper to another shop, should his work be unsatisfactory to them.
