DECLARES RABIES DOES NOT EXIST

(Continued from page one.)

"One of the surest ways of treatment for converting a dog bite, a rusty nail, pick or a wound from any cause, into hydrophobia, lockjaw or other forms of septic infection, is to cauterize the wound, even if the patient is afterwards sent to a mad dog cure.

"The kind of dressing to create septic poisoning, which may take several forms--namely rabies, lockjaw or septicemia--is to cauterize the wound--seal it up, as it were, with coagulated blood. The cautery causes a coagulation of the blood and serum, and this coagulation coats the ragged wound and retains the secretions, which rapidly decompose and are absorbed. As soon as septic symptoms develop, if the wound has been made by a dog, the disease must be hydrophobia.

Rabies Brought on by Suggestion.

"The disease is brought on by suggestion. Those cases that have a material basis--such as an improperly treated bite of any kind, ending in septicemia, or a coincidental nervous derangement, ptomaine or food poisoning of meningeal or other head diseases may, when complicated by a hydrophobic suggestion die. The majority die because of fright and lost hope.

"It is a significant fact," concluded the doctor, "that while this country is said to be over-run with rabid dogs and Pasteur Institutes, in England, where Pasteur Institutes are not allowed to ply their trade--the Pasteur Institute being outlawed and not allowed to ply their trade in English territory--rabies or hydrophobia is unheard of."

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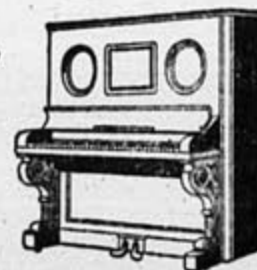

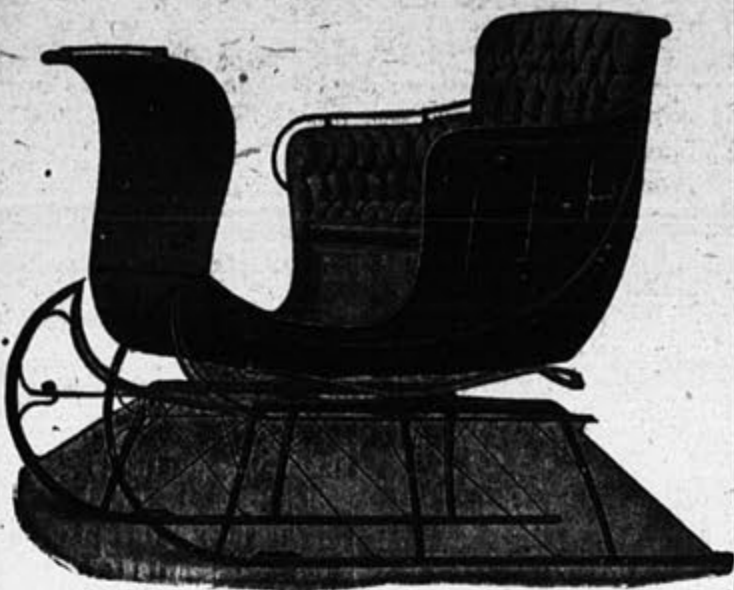
