The boat is a full rigged, three masted warship, fifty-five feet in length, drawing but four feet of water and having a capacity of thirty tons. This man-of-war can sail the water the same as the largest ship, but the crew must necessarily be limited in number. The name of this great toy is the Royal Louise, after the Prussian Queen Louise.

It was built on the Thames in 1832 and was towed down the river and across the North sea by a steamer to Hamburg. From this place it was floated by a flat barge up the Elbe into the havel at Potsdam, where it still remains.

Streets of New York City. New York city streets have a mileage of nearly 3,740, which is exactly the distance between New York and London. There are 1,905 miles of paved streets, which if placed in a connected line would reach from New York to Amarillo, Texas. The sheet and block asphalt paved streets aggregate 805 miles, equal to the distance between New York and Detroit. There are 643 miles of macadam streets.

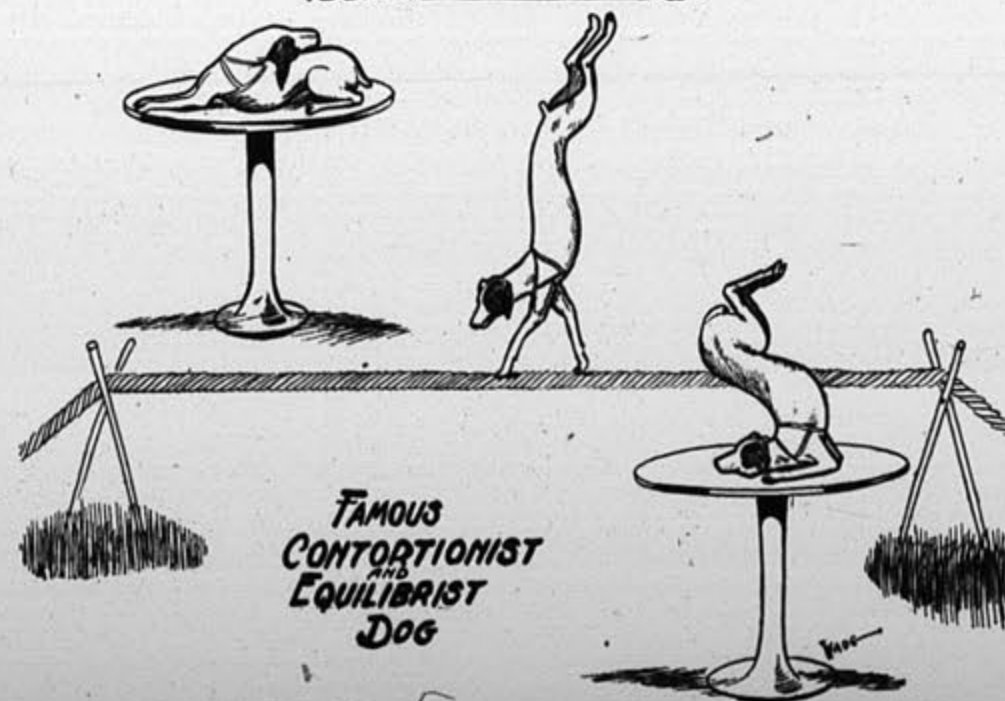
