AVOIDANCE OF PUBLIC APPEARANCE.

Government to Be the Trustee.

Mr. Carnegie's plan does not propose a national university in the sense laid out by the trustees of the University of Chicago. The government is simply to be the trustee of the magnificent endowment, just as it administers the funds bequeathed by Smithson. It is not to be a trustee in the sense of the National Institution, or in the sense of the board of directors, which is a completed staff consisting of members.
