Ferguson Bros. of this city have just secured a contract for lumbering 20,000 acres of pine in the vicinity of the head river, west and northwest of Marquette, for Kirby & White, of Albany, N. Y.

The contract is for a period of three years. They are already arranging to start a number of camps at convenient points and they will employ a large number of men.

This is probably the largest single logging contract ever made in the upper peninsula, and Ferguson Bros. are congratulating themselves upon having secured it.
