



sion of the Legislature amended the Intangi ble Tax Law. This differs materially from the original act in that the tax on money on deposit is increased to forty cents per thousand without any deduction whatsoever. The banks of the State are held responsible for the collection and remittance of the tax. The banks are required to remit the tax to the State. They may either charge it to the depositor's account or assume it themselves. Some will choose the first method and others the second.

The Directors of the two banks in Schoolcraft County have decided to assume and pay the tax and have filed the notice with the State as required by statute. Therefore, when you file your Return, you need make no statement regarding money on deposit in Banks in this county.

The foregoing applies to the intangible tax of 1947, which is payable in 1948. We do not know what the law may be in subsequent years and therefore can make no statement now as to the course then to be followed.


