Making Big Profits.
The official figures of the gold deposits on account of the Belmont Morgan gold syndicate show that \$3,340,000 has been deposited, and \$1,050,000 received after hours on storage, making a total of \$4,390,000. The assay office has weighed \$2,890,000 coin, which produces an actual weight of 155,221.19 ounces, a loss of 115.81 ounces, or \$2,154 to the syndicate caused by abrasion of the coin. At this rate, the government will make about \$50,000 on the transaction, as the coin can be paid out at its face value although received from the syndicate at its bullion valuation. The treasury has issued certificates for \$2,004,000 gold, weighed and accepted at the assay office at the syndicate price of \$17.80-12 per ounce. These certificates are convertible into 4 per cent bonds at their face value.

Spontaneous Ignition of Benzine.
The fact is well known that petroleum spirit, or benzine, is largely used in the silk and wool industries and in chemical cleaning works as a solvent for greases, oils and indurated, and has often been suspected of being the cause of those mysterious fires, which occasionally break out in works and factories where it is much used. One who has studied this phenomenon declares that the ignition of this spirit is spontaneous, and is caused by electrical excitation—that is, in certain states of the atmosphere, particularly when it is cold and dry, the spirit becomes excited, and exhibits sparks at flashes of light, to the accompaniment of crackling sounds, and the ignition of the spirit may take place at any moment.

Law of Newspapers.
WASHINGTON, March 6.—The assistant attorney general for the post-office department has made an important ruling in regard to what are known as "newspaper laws."

These so-called laws provide that subscribers to newspapers are liable for the price thereof unless they give express notice to discontinue, or when they give notice to discontinue without paying arrears, or refuse to take papers from the office, and that the publisher of a newspaper can have any one arrested for fraud who takes a paper and refuses to pay for it and that it is a dangerous trick to allow a subscription account to run on for six months or a year and a half and then to let the postmaster to mark it "refused," or send the editor a notice to discontinue the paper.

The department has been and again informed the parties making inquiries and the public generally that there are no such law. The ruling now made, however, goes beyond this. It was to the effect that a publisher who makes a demand for payment of the subscription price of his paper through the mails accompanied by a threat of enforcing such pretended law in case the demand is not complied with, may be prosecuted for attempting to obtain money under false pretenses, provided he knows that such so-called laws have no existence as law or decisions of the courts.

Canadian Canal at Saint Ste. Mar's Ontario.
The canal which has cost the dominion government nearly \$5,000,000, is the last link in the chain of waterways connecting the head of Lake Superior with the Atlantic. It is to be finished, however, considerably in advance of the other important Canadian canals along the St. Lawrence, which are being constructed on a scheme of only 14 feet depth. The main dimensions of this waterway, which will be known as the Canadian Saint canal, are 3,500 feet long, with a mean width of 152 feet, which is capable of carrying vessels drawing 20 feet of water. The lock is 900 feet in length by 60 feet wide, with a little over 20 feet of water on top of the lock. This lock is 100 feet longer and of practically the same depth as the new lock on the American side, but in width it will not admit of two of the largest lake vessels being docked abreast of each other as will the new American lock. Since the first contract was given out six years ago, the designs have been changed three times, the plans being enlarged to suit changes in dimensions of lake vessels. The first contract was for a lock 600 feet long by 85 feet wide, improving to 60 feet at the entrance, and 16 feet deep. Changes equally great have also been made in plans for the lock on the United States side since it was first designed.—*Minneapolis Leader.*

But Seeing Sights. Editor Proctor—I believe that I got down in old York State, it is not because I have forgotten you that I have not written sooner for the papers you have so kindly sent me have been at a constant reminder, but the truth is that in going from place to place and visiting with old friends and relatives, and keeping the Manhattan herald of the family posted as to my movements. My time has been pretty fully occupied. I would like to write something in praise of that magnificent winter resort on the St. Paul & Northern Pacific, called Trout Lake, but words fail me when I think of the pleasure of keeping a day amongst its snow clad swamps. You sometimes hear York states talk about how nice the winters are down in the Empire state, and knowing that I have been introduced to spots of weather here that would do no discredit to Michigan.
