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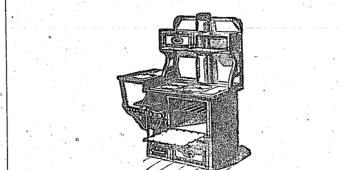

Tram Held Up.
Waukegan, Wis., Sept. 11.—Special Telegram.—The Wisconsin Central through passenger train, due here at 12:20 o'clock this evening, was held up by masked robbers two miles north of this city.

The train left Sheridan Station, the next one above here on time. The engine was derailed, and the express car was loaded with its money, the amount of which is unknown. The passengers were also robbed. The robbers escaped, but a posse is being organized in Waukegan for pursuit.

Special engine has left here for the scene of the robbery. The National Express Company operates on the Wisconsin Central.

Destructive Winds.
A tornado struck Port Austin, Tuesday night, blowing down chimney stacks, fences and trees. The wind was moving south-west and tore down many buildings, killing three children in the house of Mr. Oels, near Pine Knog.

During a heavy wind storm at Gladwin, Tuesday night, the smokestack stack was blown off from the electric works causing a great deal of damage to the roof. The top of the Gladwin, Michigan water tank was also blown off. A great many trees were uprooted, a number of sailboats were wrecked and washed ashore, causing serious loss. It was the worst wind storm ever known here.

A terrible hurricane from the northeast struck Sand Beach at 12:30 Wednesday morning, blowing down houses, barns, sheds and trees, and merrymaking buildings. Robinson Welock's fine new residence was completely destroyed. The north end of the depot was blown in, and several small boats in the harbor were capsized. Three 20-year-old were torn up by the roots. No lives were lost.

A powerful electric storm passed over Branch county, Tuesday evening, accompanied by a rain fall. No loss, but four farms were struck by lightning and consumed with their contents, one in Butler, two in Coldwater township and one in Batavia. All were insured in the Farmer's Mutual Fire Insurance Co., of that county.

A windstorm at Manistee, Tuesday night, played havoc with things generally. Several plate-glass fronts were blown in, and several mill saws were blown down.
