

Tombstone Transcriptions
Boot Hill Cemetery
Seney, Schoolcraft County, Michigan

From Hwy M-28 in Seney, go south 0.5 miles on County Road 456 (Seney Ave). The cemetery is located on the right hand side on a small hill. It is adjacent to a new cemetery, Whispering Pines.

The cemetery has been abandoned and is no longer in use. Someone has placed at least 38 painted wooden crosses at depressions that mark burial sites. Inscriptions on the few tombstones and markers that remain were transcribed as they appear.

- YYYY - Birth date present but no death date
- YYYY Death date present but no birth date

- Space for a numeral but none present (e. g. 19--)
