To find the cemetery, go 0.9 mile north of US 2 on County Road 442 through the town of Cooks. Turn right on Cemetery Road. The cemetery is located 0.4 mile east of County Road 442 on the south side of the road.

Inscriptions on the tombstones and markers were transcribed as they appear on the stone. The listing is divided by Section. The transcriptions are not necessarily in order of the rows within the section due to the fact that the markers are not consistently placed at the head or foot of the grave. The sections were read from west to east.
