

FOREWORD

This publication is a prototype, first issuance of limited distribution. It combines information from the *Map Book of Major Military Installations* with information pertaining to military and civilian manpower, payroll outlays, and prime contract awards by state. It is intended to provide useful summary information to satisfy the needs of a variety of Federal government users.

This report was developed through a manual assimilation of already available computerized information which had been collected and processed to satisfy recurring information requirements of the Office of the Secretary of Defense and central management agencies of the Federal government. In subsequent years, the statistical data tables in this report are expected to be generated from computerized files in conjunction with processing other information requirements.

Your comments concerning this first issuance are welcome and will be considered when finalizing specifications for future issuances. 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INTRODUCTION

INTRODUCTION

BACKGROUND

Since 1955, the Department of Defense (DOD) has published on a biennial basis the *Map Book of Major Military Installations*. This publication was intended to provide DOD managers a convenient reference for identification of major military installations in the United States. Prior to each issuance, the last of which was in June 1982, the Military Departments provided input concerning the installations to be included.

In the late 1970's, it was suggested by officials within the Office of the Secretary of Defense that the information in the "Map Book" be combined with other DOD geographical information in order to satisfy several requirements in one, easily accessible publication. In 1981, a prototype was developed for comment. From the comments received, a format was developed for the statistical abstract table for each state which is included in this report. This table is devoted entirely to information on DOD personnel, payroll outlays, and prime contracts over \$10,000.

Information in this statistical abstract table is for the most part provided according to Military Department with a total for "Other Defense Activities". Personnel information includes both active duty military and direct hire civilian personnel. Payroll outlays and prime contract awards over \$10,000 are combined to provide an indication of total expenditures for each state. These data are also broken down by type of payroll and category of contract, respectively. In addition, the following information is provided for each state: (1) 10 locations where the largest expenditures were made and the most personnel were located; (2) total prime contract awards over \$10,000 for the past three fiscal years; and (3) the top five contractors, their total awards, major areas of work, and major locations of performance.

NOTES ON COVERAGE

Personnel. Personnel data include total active duty military and direct hire civilian personnel as of September 30, 1982. The military personnel include those based ashore and exclude those which are temporarily shore-based or afloat. In addition, military personnel in each department include a number of personnel in a transient status. The Marine Corps and Air Force report these personnel at their last assigned location prior to their arrival at their new permanent duty location. The Army and Navy include these personnel in one category entitled "Undistributed" which may also include personnel for which an exact location is undetermined. As of September 30, 1982, there were 37,800 personnel reported in this category which could not be distributed by state.

In some instances, the Military Departments report personnel by parent installation rather than their operating location. Such variations tend to occur in metropolitan areas where military activities are scattered among political jurisdictions. In addition, some personnel on temporary duty as of September 30, 1982, may be reported at their assigned locations.

Excluded from the direct hire civilian personnel are those not subject to Office of Management and Budget (OMB) ceiling controls. As of September 30, 1982, the Department of Defense employed 10,896 nonceiling personnel in the United States.

Finally, Department of the Army civilian personnel include employees involved in civil functions in the United States. This consisted of 31,365 employees of the Army Corps of Engineers and 137 Army cemeterial employees. Also included in this report are four personnel performing civil functions in the Air Force.

Payroll Outlays. Information provided for payroll outlays must be termed estimated because much of it includes calculated and prorated data. Although the data are based on actual payroll information, in many instances actual data has been prorated to the installation or city level using calculations based on the number of personnel and average salary at an installation or the location of interest.

Payroll outlays comprise gross earnings of personnel which, except for retired military personnel compensation, include gross compensation for personnel services rendered the government and cash allowances for personnel benefits. Excluded from gross earnings for employees is the employer's share of employee benefits.

The user of estimated payroll outlays information should also be aware of problems involved with the location of reported payrolls. Reporting of payroll outlays by the location of the finance office issuing the checks can occur. This could mean that military and civilian pay for the same installation may be reported at different locations if paid by different finance offices.

Finally, payroll outlays for military personnel who are temporarily shore-based or afloat are reported at the personnel's home port.

Prime Contracts. Data provided for each state reflect the net value of debit and credit procurement actions over \$10,000. If a total for a procurement category for a state was a net deficit, the value is indicated in parentheses. In addition, prime contract awards of \$10,000 or less are not included in this report since records pertaining to the locations of performance are not maintained.

In regard to the locations reported for contracts, contract work is not necessarily performed at the location where the contract was awarded. Most manufacturing contracts have been attributed to the contractor's location where the product will be processed and assembled. When contract work will be performed at more than one plant, the contract has been attributed to the location where the largest dollar amount of work will be performed. Both construction and service contracts have been attributed to the state where the work is to be performed. Contracts for transportation and communications services have been attributed to the state where the contractor's home office is located. For purchases from wholesale or other distribution firms, the location is the contractor's business address.

Availability of Additional Information. The Directorate for Information Operations and Reports, Washington Headquarters Services produces numerous publications in the areas of DOD personnel, payroll outlays, and prime contract awards. In addition, DIOR maintains detailed information in these areas on computer or on microfiche. A guide to the type of information available is provided in the appendix.




MAP NO. 6

LOS ANGELES AREA




MAP NO. 7







APPENDIX

GUIDE TO OTHER, MORE DETAILED DATA ON PERSONNEL, PAYROLL OUTLAYS, AND PROCUREMENT

Personnel. The Directorate for Information Operations and Reports (DIOR) publishes an annual report as of September 30 each year entitled *Distribution of Personnel by State and by Selected Locations*. In this publication, data are provided on the number and operating location of DOD active duty military and direct hire civilian personnel in each of the 50 states, by state, according to Defense component. Detailed data are provided in separate tables for major installations and selected cities in each state, according to Defense component.

Also available is a detailed computer listing of the number of active duty military and direct hire civilians for all locations in the United States at which they are reported. This listing also includes information by home port for active duty military personnel of the Navy or Marine Corps who are afloat or temporarily shore-based.

Payroll Outlays. Annually DIOR publishes detailed information on DOD payroll outlays by geographic location in the United States and U.S. territories. Information by Defense component is available on microfiche for active duty military pay, civilian pay, and reserve and National Guard pay, by the state, county, and city where work is performed. Information is also available on military retired pay according to the geographic location of the retired person.

Payroll Outlays and Contract Obligations. DIOR publishes annual computer listings of payroll outlays and contract obligations by state and county within each state. Data are provided by operating location for payroll outlays (except military retired pay, which is by location of the retiree), by place of performance for obligations of funds for prime contract awards over \$10,000, and by purchasing office location for obligations of funds for prime contract awards of \$10,000 or less.

Prime Contract Awards Over \$10,000 by State. DIOR publishes two detailed annual reports showing the net value of DOD prime contract awards over \$10,000 by place of performance in the 50 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. One report is arrayed by state, county, contractor name, and city. The other is by state, city, and contractor name. Both reports show a contractor's name and associated dollar amount of contract awards for each separate place of performance. The aggregate value of the contractor's awards in each location is provided, with information displayed according to the Defense component making the award. Data can be requested by state or for selected counties within a state.

Information on Ordering Publications. DIOR publishes an annual catalog providing descriptions and costs of major publications and statistical information such as described above.
