FOREWORD

This publication is prepared from Military Department and Agency submissions under DoD-wide instructions for reporting of personnel by operating location. It reflects a planned transition toward future publications based upon consistent city or military installations/activity locations by county and state. Because of the transition aspects, users of this document should be aware of the limitations outlined below.

Within states, the major concentrations of personnel are shown by city or installation location. An asterisk indicates a principal military installation. However, in some cases, coding to "parent" installation or an "assigned" activity may occur and result in reporting elements to different place names (city vs military installation vs sub-activity). Such variations tend to occur in metropolitan areas where military activities are scattered physically among multiple political jurisdictions or sub areas thereof.

Special attention is called to the following:

1. The Department of the Army civilians for each state include Corps of Engineers Civil Functions personnel as well as National Guard Technicians.
2. The Department of the Navy military personnel includes Marine Corps. Navy personnel are shore-based only and exclude afloat and temporary shore-based military personnel (who are reported with afloat units).
3. Not included in the civilian data are 7,960 special youth employees not subject to statutory limitations (largely "Stay-in-School") most of whom are part-time employees. Of these, 988 were in the Washington Metropolitan Area.
