

Bond Falls Project #1864

We, the community members, taxpayers, residents, environmentalists, and sports enthusiasts, both young and old alike, firmly support the continued progress of Bond Falls Project #1864. We look forward to the future enhancements which will be made to the project lands that surround the Bond Reservoir. This property, which remains with UPPCO, is and will continue to be cautiously managed according to FERC guidelines. When UPPCO's Shoreline Management Plan (SMP) is completed and submitted to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), these enhancements can include, but are not limited to docks, both public and private, gazebos, nature trails, modern as well as rustic camp sites, a pavilion, boat landings, steps leading down to the water, all of which will increase and improve the public's access to the Bond Falls Reservoir and finally make Bond accessible to handicapped individuals. We're aware that the restriction or elimination of these enhancements, most notably that of private docks, will significantly reduce, by as much as 50%, the projected revenue for police and fire protection, senior citizen programs, local government agencies and the Ewen-Trout Creek School District.

We ask that you take the necessary steps to insure the continued progress and completion of this environmentally mindful project not only for the benefit of the local communities, their economy and school system, but virtually that of the entire western end of the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. Bond Falls Project #1864 and the future development plans by Naterra Land, along with the enhancements included in UPPCO's Shoreline Management Plan, will be beneficial to all as it will increase and reinforce the continued access and use of the Bond Falls Reservoir by the public for generations to come.


