To this end we are expending and shall continue to expend large sums of money in the construction of an entirely new and up-to-date coalgas plant with new mains and services and in a thorough and effective overhauling and returnishing of the power plant and the electric light and street car service.

The prices we charge shall be in every instance public property and shall be the same to all for the same service rendered.

We shall expect and exact the same prompt payment from all customers.

While there will necessarily be some delay in rounding all things into shop, we announce the new rates for electric current, said rates taking effect for consumption from and after the time of the last meter readings in December.

Minimum bill \$1.00 flat, no discount.

First 40,000 watts at 15c. per 1000 watts-15% discount for payment within first 10 days All after first 40,000 watts at 15c. per 1,000 watts-20% discount for payment within first ten days.

Electric Signs-properly so-called-current at 11c. per 1,000 watts-20% discount for payment within first ten days.

Motors--current at 10c. per 1,000 watts-discount 20% for payment within first ten days.

Discount on no bill allowed if bill is not paid within first ten days of month when same matures.
