To Our Street Railway Patrons:

Owing to the abuse of the use of the three cent commutation tickets we will have to withdraw the sale of same. The tickets are not only used by persons who have no just right to use them. but some parties are peddling them at a profit to themselves, while they themselves are reaping a profit on the sale, and yet they have not a dollar invested in the street railway.

If this abuse was permitted to go on unchecked it would gradually put the street railway out of business, as we are carrying more passen-gers month after month and yet the receipts are

The following statement will illustrate how the abuse of these tickets is reducing our income and showing a loss to us.
