## M. O. COSTLY AT WHITEHALL

The municipal light and water plant at Whitehall is a losing proposition and the taxpayers are paying the piper as usual, and probably without realizing it, as in the cases of most municipal plants it is hard to get an accurate accounting of expenses. For the year ended March 1, 1913, the plants showed a deficit of \$1,127, though it was credited with \$3,195 for village water and light. The deficit for the fiscal year ended March 1 last is \$1,597, and it is safe to say that no interest, taxes or depreciation has been charged against it. The deficit is really greater than the meager figures of the plant's operation shows. The village is still being charged \$42 per year for 32 arc lamps, while incandescent clusters have supplanted all the arcs. As new incandescent clusters are charged at only \$16 per year, the 32 clusters which supplanted the arc lights are certainly charged at a

pretty nigh rate.

Whitehall tax-payers would be money ahead if the lighting plant were "junked," and the village purchased its light.-Chicago Tribune.


