Prohibition History in Michigan

Back in the late 60's and early 70's there was prohibition all over the state of Michigan.

It got unbearable, a regular ring of terror, and even the temperance cranks united with the rest of the citizens in Ann Arbor to pass an ordinance to license saloons.

This was gotten around for, there was no mention made of the sale of liquor, simply saloons. The saloon-keepers were put under \$300 bonds that their places were to be closed at certain hours.

There was a Mr. Kidson who questioned the validity of this enactment. The supreme court held that the ordinance was valid and could be enacted even while prohibition was in the state--the ordinance having said nothing regarding the sale of liquor.

I never saw so much drunkenness among students as there was during this prohibition period.
