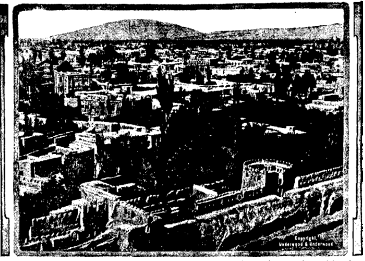

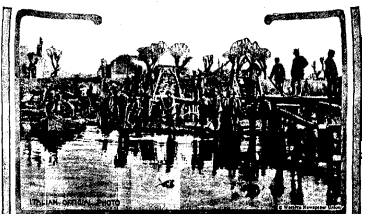

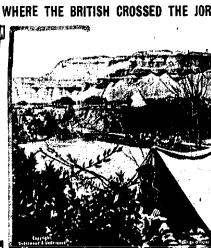

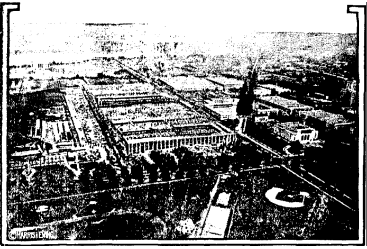

Are the Packers Profiteers?
Plain Facts About the Meat Business

The Federal Trade Commission in its recent report on the profits of the large meat packers has been professing that they have a monopoly of the market. This conclusion, if fair and just, on matters of serious concern not only to those engaged in the meat packing business but to every other citizen of our country.

The figures given on profits are misleading and the statement that the packers have a monopoly is unsupported by the facts.

The profits mentioned in the report read merely to prove their profits reasonable and necessary.

The meat business is one of the largest American industries. Any citizen who would foster himself with its health must be prepared for large facts.

The report states that the aggregate profits of four large packers was \$1,000,000 for the three year period.

This sum is compared with \$7,000,000 as the average annual profit for the three years before the war, making it appear that the net profit was \$2,000,000 greater than the pre-war profit.

This compares a three-year profit with a one-year profit—a manifestly unfair method of comparison. It is not only misleading but the Federal Trade Commission apparently has made a mistake in the figures themselves.

The aggregate three-year profit of \$1,000,000 was carried on sales of over four and a half billion dollars. It means about five cents on each dollar of sales or a mere fraction of a cent per dollar of sales.

No evidence is offered by the Federal Trade Commission in support of the statement that the large packers have a monopoly. The Commission's own report shows the large number and importance of other packers.

The packers mentioned in the statement stand ready to prove to any fair-minded person that they are in keen competition with each other, and that they are no more to monopolize prices.

Furthermore, government figures show that the five large packers mentioned in the report account for only about one-twelfth of the total business of the country.

They will be unable to interest you in the details of their business. If, however, for instance, they say they derived profit for less than the cost of the live animal, owing to utilization of by-products, and of the wonderful utility of the methods of distribution throughout the home land, as well as in other countries.

The five packers mentioned had justified in presenting with each other to the extent of together producing this public statement.

They have been able to do a big job for your government in its time of need; they have not said any more than they should and they are willing to let their facts do for them the same thing that the facts have done for them.
