# Are the Packers Profiteers?

### Plain Facts About the Meat Business

The Pederal Trade Commission in its recent report on war profits, stated that the five large meat purkers have been profiteering and that they have a monopoly of the market.

These conclusions, if fair and just, are matters of serious concern not only to those engaged in the most parking business but to every other citizen of our country.

The figures given on profits are misleading and the state-ment that the packets have a monopoly is unsupported by

The packers mentioned in the report stand ready to prove their profits reasonable and necessary.

The most business is one of the largest American industries. Any citizen who would familiarize himself with its details must be prepared for large totals.

The report states that the aggregate profits of four large buckers were \$140,000,000 for the three war rears.

This sum is constanted with \$19,000,000 or the average annual profit for the three years before the war, making it appear that the war profit was \$121,000,000 greater than the pre-war profit.

This compares a three-year profit with a one-year profit-a manifestly unfair method of comparison. It is not only mideading, but the Federal Trade Commission apparently has made a mistake in the figures themselves.

The aggregate three-year predix of \$140,000,000 was carried on sales of ever four and a tail billion dollars. It means alout three-ents on each dollar of sales—or a mere fraction of a cent per pound of predixet.

Packers' profits are a negligible factor in prices of live sto k and means. No other large inciness is conducted upon such small margins of prefit.

Furthermore- and this is very important-only a small runvermore—and this is very important—only a small partion of this profit has been paid in dividends. The balance has been put back into the businesses. It had to be, as you realize when you consider the problems the packets have had to solve—and solve quickly—during there

To conduct this business in war times, with higher costs and the necessity of paying two or three times the former prices for live stock, has required the use of two or three times the ordinary amount of working capital. The additional profit makee only a fair return on this, and as has been stated, the larger portion of the profits carned has been used to finance lunge stocks of goods and to provide additions and improvements made necessary by the encemous demands of our army and many and the allies.

If you are a business man you will appreciate the signifi-cance of these facts. If you are manequainted with busi-ness, talk this matter over with seme business sequaint-ence—with your banker, agr-and sak him to compare profits of the pucking industry with those of any other large industry at the present time.

No evidence is offered by the Pederal Trade Commission in support of the statement that the large parkers have a monopoly. The Commission's own report shows the large number and impuriance of other packers

prove to any fair-minded person that they are in keen competition with each other, and that they have no power to munipulate prices.

If this were not true they would not dare to make this

Furthermore, government figures show that the five large packers mentioned in the report account for only about one-third of the meat incises of the country.

They wish it were possible to interest you in the details of their business. Of how, for instance, they can sell densed heef for less than the cost of the live assimal, owing to utilization of by-products, and of the wonderful story of the methods of distribution foroughout this broad hand, as well as in other countries.

The five packers mentioned feel justified in co-operating with each other to the extent of together presenting this public statement.

They have been able to do a big job for your government in its time of need; they have not all war time demands promptly and completely and they are willing to trust their case to the fairmindedness of the American people with
