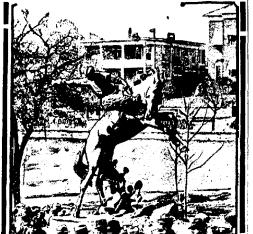


Cable From America to Italy Being Landed

Texas Receives Statue of Cowboy



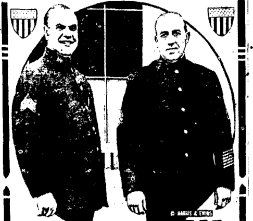

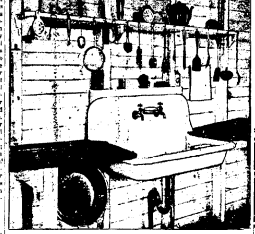
