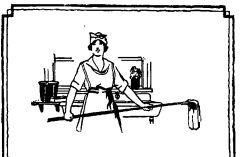

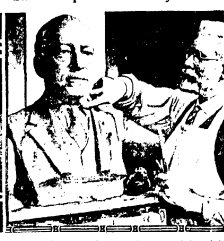

Portrait of a man in military uniform, likely a member of Lee's staff.

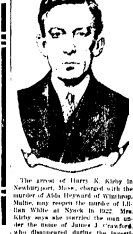
