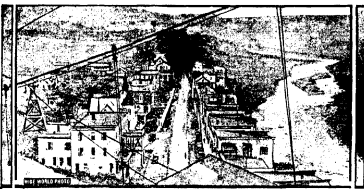

Artificial Lake Will Engulf This Village



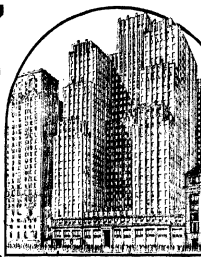

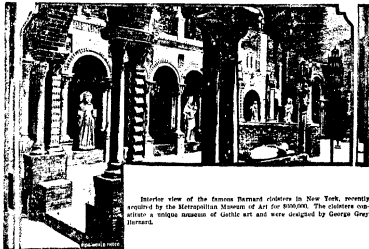
