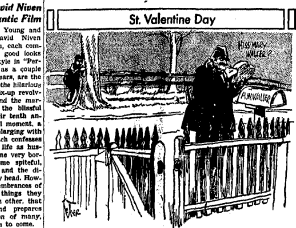

'DON'T GET UPSET!' Soaring Winter Accident Toll Sparks Plea for Safe Driving

CHICAGO—When getting snow and treacherous ice clog the highways, "don't get upset" is the plea of National Safety Council in its campaign to reduce the hazards of winter driving.

Over a score, two-thirds of the cold weather mishaps last year occurred on snowy or icy roads. It is revealed in a special study of winter traffic accidents recently completed by four typical snow-blast states in co-operation with the National Safety Council.

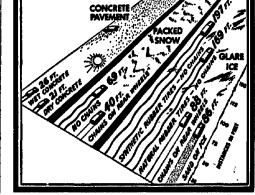
The study indicates the percentage of winter accidents in the northern half of the United States increased from 24 to 29 percent last winter. In the southern half, the increase was from 17 to 20 percent. The study also shows that the number of winter accidents increased 10 percent in the last six months of the year.

Blurred Vision

Inadequate traction and poor visibility are the most common causes of winter accidents, according to Fred Ralph, a. Motor of Iowa State college, chairman of the council's committee on winter driving hazards.
