Pots and Pans Part of Secret To Save Vitamins

Homebodies are spending big dollars for cooking equipment these days with the prospect of cooking to save vitamins. A few suggestions from Pauline Thibault, member of the National Housewives Union, may help you decide what equipment you need to cook efficiently. Nutritive value is not the only in-

variant factor in cooking. If your diet is deficient in vitamins, you may iron and cook your food to save vitamins you need so hard to save. There are two ways to save vitamins from food. One is to freeze food. There is no loss of vitamins in freezing food so long as it is sealed. The other way is to allow them to remain in the food. There are three points to remember to save vitamins in cooking. Cook foods in the shortest possible time, at the lowest possible temperature and with the least water. Again you have to consider the food to be cooked. If you cook long steamed vegetables like onions, leeks, cauliflower, beans in too small an amount of water, you will lose vitamins. More water will prevent it. If you cook peas in a closed dish they will turn blue green. If you serve your family by eating the food because it is tasty and attractive can get any vitamins at all.

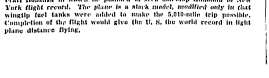
